- Then David added; Yehowah, who delivered me from the paw of the lion and from the paw of the bear, he it is who **will** deliver me from the **hand** of this Philistine. At this Saul said to David; Go, and may Yehowah himself prove to be with you. (**1 Samuel 17:37**)
- With someone loyal you **will** act in loyalty, with the faultless, mighty one you **will** deal faultlessly. (**2 Samuel 22:26**)
- Yehowah is my light and my salvation. Of whom shall I be in fear? Yehowah is the stronghold of my life. Of whom shall I be in dread? (**Psalms 27:1**)
- The name of Yehowah is a strong tower. Into it the righteous runs and is given protection. (**Proverbs 18:10**)
- Look! God is my salvation. I shall trust and be in no dread, for Yah, Yehowah is my strength and my might, and he came to be the salvation of me. (**Isaiah 12:2**)
- He is rescuing and delivering and performing signs and wonders in the heavens and on the earth, for he has rescued Daniel from the paw of the lions. (**Daniel 6:27**)
- But as for me, it is for Yehowah that I shall keep on the lookout. I **will** show a waiting attitude for the God of my salvation. My God **will** hear me. (**Micah 7:7**)
- From such a great thing as death he did **rescue** us and **will rescue** us, and our hope is in him that he **will** also **rescue** us further. (**2 Corinthians 1:10**)

- When Reuben heard this he tried to deliver him **out** of their **hand**. So he said; Let us not strike his soul fatally. (**Genesis 37:21**)
- And Yehowah **will** help them and provide them with escape. He **will** provide them with escape from wicked people and save them, because they have taken refuge in him. (**Psalms 37:40**)
- You **will** not need to be afraid of any sudden dreadful thing, nor of the storm upon the wicked ones, because it is coming. (**Proverbs 3:25**)
- And whoever does not fall down and worship **will** at the same moment be thrown into the **burning fiery** furnace. (**Daniel 3:6**)
- So that we may be of good courage and say; Yehowah is my helper, I **will** not be afraid. What can man do to me? (**Hebrews 13:6**)
