- I said; I will guard my ways to keep from sinning with my **tongue**. I will set a muzzle as a guard to my own mouth, as long as anyone wicked is in front of me. (**Psalms 39:1**)
- The calmness of the **tongue** is a tree of life, but distortion in it means a breaking down in the spirit. (**Proverbs 15:4**)
- If any man seems to himself to be a formal worshiper and yet does not bridle his **tongue**, but goes on deceiving his own heart, this man's form of worship is futile. (**James 1:26**)
- But the **tongue**, not one of mankind can get it tamed. An unruly injurious thing, it is full of death-dealing poison. (**James 3:8**)
- It is the lip of truth that will be firmly established forever, but the **tongue** of falsehood will be only as long as a moment. (**Proverbs 12:19**)
- False **lips** are something detestable to Yehowah, but those acting in faithfulness are a pleasure to him. (**Proverbs 12:22**)
- Do not be lying to one another. Strip off the old personality with its practices. (**Colossians 3:9**)
- Accordingly, put away all badness and all deceitfulness and hypocrisy and envies and all sorts of backbiting. (**1 Peter 2:1**)
- He has not slandered with his **tongue**. To his companion he has done nothing **bad**, and no reproach has he taken up **against** his intimate acquaintance. (**Psalms 15:3**)

- **Anyone innocent in his hands and clean in heart, who has not carried My soul to sheer worthlessness, nor taken an oath deceitfully. (Psalms 24:4)**
- **For, he that would love life and see good days, let him restrain his tongue from what is bad and his lips from speaking deception. (1 Peter 3:10)**
