• And they tried to fool him with their mouth, and with their tongue they tried to lie to him. (Psalms 78:36)

• And their heart was not steadfast with him, and they did not prove faithful in his covenant. (Psalms 78:37)

• Return, YOU people, to the One against whom the sons of Israel have gone deep in their revolt. (Isaiah 31:6)

Because the senseless one himself will speak mere senselessness, and his very heart will work at what is hurtful, to work at apostasy and to speak against Yehowah what is wayward, to cause the soul of the hungry one to go empty, and he causes even the thirsty one to go without drink itself. (Isaiah 32:6)

• But this very people has come to have a stubborn and rebellious heart, they have turned aside and keep walking in their course. (Jeremiah 5:23)

• O Yehowah, the hope of Israel, all those who are leaving you will be put to shame. Those apostatizing from me will be written down even in the earth, because they have left the source of living water, Yehowah. (Jeremiah 17:13)

Beware, brothers, for fear there should ever develop in any one of you a wicked heart lacking faith by drawing away from the living God. (Hebrews 3:12) • Offspring of vipers, how can you speak good things, when you are wicked? For out of the abundance of the heart the mouth speaks. (Matthew 12:34)

• Call out full-throated, do not hold back. Raise your voice just like a horn, and tell my people their revolt, and the house of Jacob their sins. (Isaiah 58:1)

• The heart is more treacherous than anything else and is desperate. Who can know it? (Jeremiah 17:9)
