TRUST - DO NOT TRUST IN NOBLES, EARTHLING MAN

Men ··· Righteous ··· Trust - Do not put trust in nobles nor in any man to whom no salvation belongs (Psalms 146:3) [18] - References

Psalms 146:3... Do not put YOUR trust in nobles, nor in the son of earthling man, to whom no salvation belongs.

[18] - References

- Indeed the sons of earthling man are an exhalation, the sons of mankind are a lie. When laid upon the scales they are all together lighter than an exhalation. (Psalms 62:9)
- It is better to take refuge in Yehowah than to trust in nobles. (Psalms 118:9)
- It is better to take refuge in Yehowah than to trust in earthling man. (Psalms 118:8)
- For YOUR own sakes, hold off from the earthling man, whose breath is in his nostrils, for on what basis is he himself to be taken into account? (Isaiah 2:22)
- This is what Yehowah has said; Cursed is the able-bodied man who puts his trust in earthling man and actually makes flesh his arm, and whose heart turns away from Yehowah himself. (Jeremiah 17:5)
- So the landowners of Shechem set ambush men for him upon the tops of the mountains, and they would rob everyone that would pass by them on the road. In time it was reported to Abimelech. (Judges 9:25)
- To this he said; If Yehowah does not save you, from what source shall I save you? either from the threshing floor or from the wine or oil press? (2 Kings 6:27)
- So Ahaz sent messengers to Tiglath-pileser the king of Assyria, saying; I am your servant and your son. Come up and save me out of the palm of the king of Syria and out of the palm of the king of Israel, who are rising up against me. (2 Kings 16:7)
- And at that time Hanani the seer came to Asa the king of Judah and then said to him; Because you leaned upon the king of Syria and

did not lean upon Yehowah your God, for that reason the military force of the king of Syria has escaped out of your hand. (2 Chronicles 16:7)

- Here is the able-bodied man that does not put God as his fortress, but that trusts in the abundance of his riches, that takes shelter in adversities by him. (Psalms 52:7)
- Do give us assistance from distress, as salvation by earthling man is worthless. (Psalms 60:11)
- Surely you will die just as men do, and like any one of the princes you will fall! (Psalms 82:7)
- Do give us assistance from distress, as salvation by earthling man is worthless. (Psalms 108:12)
- I, for my part, said, when I became panicky; Every man is a liar. (Psalms 116:11)
- And they will certainly be terrified and be ashamed of Ethiopia their looked-for hope and of Egypt their beauty. (Isaiah 20:5)
- The Egyptians, though, are earthling men, and not God, and their horses are flesh, and not spirit. And Yehowah himself will stretch out his hand, and he that is offering help will have to stumble, and he that is being helped will have to fall, and at the same time they will all of them come to an end. (Isaiah 31:3)
