Psalms 49:6... Those who are trusting in their means of maintenance, and who keep boasting about the abundance of their riches.

- And you do say in your heart, My own power and the full might of my own hand have made this wealth for me. (Deuteronomy 8:17)
- Here is the able-bodied man that does not put God as his fortress, but that trusts in the abundance of his riches, that takes shelter in adversities by him. (Psalms 52:7)
- The valuable things of a rich man are his strong town. The ruin of the lowly ones is their poverty. (Proverbs 10:15)
- The valuable things of the rich are his strong town, and they are like a protective wall in his imagination. (Proverbs 18:11)
- Give orders to those who are rich in the present system of things not to be high-minded, and to rest their hope, not on uncertain riches, but on God, who furnishes us all things richly for our enjoyment. (1 Timothy 6:17)
- Because everything in the world, the desire of the flesh and the desire of the eyes and the showy display of one's means of life, does not originate with the Father, but originates with the world. (1 John 2:16)
- And Haman proceeded to declare to them the glory of his riches and the large number of his sons and everything with which the king had magnified him and how he had exalted him over the princes and the servants of the king. (Esther 5:11)
