Proverbs 19:21... Many are the plans in the heart of a man, but the counsel of Yehowah is what will stand.

- After that Yehowah said; Look! They are one people and there is one language for them all, and this is what they start to do. Why, now there is nothing that they may have in mind to do that will be unattainable for them. (Genesis 11:6)
- But when Esther came in before the king he said with the written document; Let his bad scheme that he has schemed against the Jews come back upon his own head, and they hanged him and his sons upon the stake. (Esther 9:25)
- For they have directed against you what is bad, they have thought out ideas that they are unable to carry out. (Psalms 21:11)
- The heart of earthling man may think out his way, but Yehowah himself does the directing of his steps. (Proverbs 16:9)
- See! This only I have found, that the true God made mankind upright, but they themselves have sought out many plans. (Ecclesiastes 7:29)
- These have one thought, and so they give their power and authority to the wild beast. (Revelation 17:13)
- Come now! Let us go down and there confuse their language that they may not listen to one another's language. (Genesis 11:7)
- As for you, you had evil in mind against me. God had it in mind for good for the purpose of acting as at this day to preserve many people alive. (Genesis 50:20)
- Now, look! I am going today in the way of all the earth, and you well know with all your hearts and with all your souls that not one word out of all the good words that Yehowah your God has spoken to

YOU has failed. They have all come true for YOU. Not one word of them has failed. (Joshua 23:14)

- There is no wisdom, nor any discernment, nor any counsel in opposition to Yehowah. (Proverbs 21:30)
- And all the inhabitants of the earth are being considered as merely nothing, and he is doing according to his own will among the army of the heavens and the inhabitants of the earth. And there exists no one that can check his hand or that can say to him, What have you been doing? (Daniel 4:35)
- But if it is from God, you will not be able to overthrow them, otherwise, you may perhaps be found fighters actually against God. (Acts of Apostles 5:39)
- In this manner God, when he purposed to demonstrate more abundantly to the heirs of the promise the unchangeableness of his counsel, stepped in with an oath. (Hebrews 6:17)
- At this Balaam said to Balak; Here I have come to you now. Shall I be able at all to speak something? The word that God will place in my mouth is what I shall speak. (Numbers 22:38)
- So I said to myself, Now the Philistines will come down against me at Gilgal, and the face of Yehowah I have not softened. So I compelled myself and went offering up the burnt sacrifice. (1 Samuel 13:12)
- Then Absalom and all the men of Israel said; The counsel of Hushai the Archite is better than the counsel of Ahithophel! And Yehowah himself had given command to frustrate the counsel of Ahithophel although good, in order, that Yehowah might bring calamity upon Absalom. (2 Samuel 17:14)
- And Solomon began seeking to put Jeroboam to death. So Jeroboam got up and went running off to Egypt to Shishak the king of Egypt, and he continued in Egypt until Solomon's death. (1 Kings 11:40)
- To time indefinite the very counsel of Yehowah will stand, the thoughts of his heart are to one generation after another generation. (Psalms 33:11)
- Keep silent before Yehowah and wait longingly for him. Do not show yourself heated up at anyone making his way successful, at the man carrying out his ideas. (Psalms 37:7)

- To earthling man belong the arrangings of the heart, but from Yehowah is the answer of the tongue. (Proverbs 16:1)
- Yehowah of armies has sworn, saying; Surely just as I have figured, so it must occur, and just as I have counseled, that is what will come true. (Isaiah 14:24)
- For Yehowah of armies himself has counseled, and who can break it up? And his hand is the one stretched out, and who can turn it back? (Isaiah 14:27)
- And the spirit of Egypt must become bewildered in the midst of it, and I shall confuse its own counsel. And they will be certain to resort to the valueless gods and to the charmers and to the spirit mediums and to the professional foretellers of events. (Isaiah 19:3)
- Therefore hear, O men, the counsel of Yehowah that he has formulated against Edom, and his thoughts that he has thought out against the inhabitants of Teman; Surely the little ones of the flock will be dragged about. Surely on account of them he will make their dwelling place become desolate. (Jeremiah 49:20)
- Who, now, has said that something should occur when Yehowah himself has not commanded? (Lamentations 3:37)
- And that which is coming up into YOUR spirit will itself positively not happen, in that YOU are saying; Let us become like the nations, like the families of the lands, in ministering to wood and stone. (Ezekiel 20:32)
- And he will set his face to come with the forcefulness of his entire kingdom, and there will be equitable terms with him, and he will act effectively. And as regards the daughter of womankind, it will be granted to him to bring her to ruin. And she will not stand, and she will not continue to be his. (Daniel 11:17)
- And as regards these two kings, their heart will be inclined to doing what is bad, and at one table a lie is what they will keep speaking. But nothing will succeed, because the end is yet for the time appointed. (Daniel 11:27)
