TRUST - IN WEAPONS OF WAR FOR SALVATION

Men … Unrighteous … Trust In Weapons Of War - Men trust in horses (in warfare) for salvation but salvation belongs to Yehowah (Proverbs 21:31) [34] - References

Proverbs 21:31... The horse is something prepared for the day of battle, but salvation belongs to Yehowah.

- Some concerning chariots and others concerning horses, but, as for us, concerning the name of Yehowah our God we shall make mention. (Psalms 20:7)
- Woe to those going down to Egypt for assistance, those who rely on mere horses, and who put their trust in war chariots, because they are numerous, and in steeds, because they are very mighty, but who have not looked to the Holy One of Israel and have not searched for Yehowah himself. (Isaiah 31:1)
- Harness the horses, and mount, O you horsemen, and station yourselves with the helmet. Polish the lances. Clothe yourselves with coats of mail. (Jeremiah 46:4)
- And I saw the heaven opened, and, look! A white horse. And the one seated upon it is called Faithful and True, and he judges and carries on war in righteousness. (Revelation 19:11)
- You will not need to fight in this instance. Take YOUR position, stand still and see the salvation of Yehowah in YOUR behalf. O Judah and Jerusalem, do not be afraid or be terrified. Tomorrow go out against them, and Yehowah will be with YOU. (2 Chronicles 20:17)
- Salvation belongs to Yehowah. Your blessing is upon your people. (Psalms 3:8)
- The horse is a deception for salvation, and by the abundance of its vital energy it does not afford escape. (Psalms 33:17)
- The true God is for us a God of saving acts, and to Yehowah the Sovereign Lord belong the ways out from death. (Psalms 68:20)

- And they keep on crying with a loud voice, saying; Salvation we owe to our God, who is seated on the throne, and to the Lamb. (Revelation 7:10)
- When Pharaoh's horses with his war chariots and his cavalrymen went into the sea, then Yehowah brought back the waters of the sea upon them, while the sons of Israel walked on dry land through the midst of the sea. (Exodus 15:19)
- Only he should not increase horses for himself, nor make the people go back to Egypt in order to increase horses, whereas Yehowah has said to You, You must never go back again by this way. (Deuteronomy 17:16)
- In case you go out to the battle against your enemies and you actually see horses and war chariots, a people more numerous than you, you must not be afraid of them, for Yehowah your God is with you, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt. (Deuteronomy 20:1)
- Then You, You will rise up from the ambush, and You must take possession of the city, and Yehowah Your God will certainly give it into YOUR hands. (Joshua 8:7)
- So they went out, they and all their camps with them, a people as numerous as the grains of sand that are on the seashore for multitude, and very many horses and war chariots. (Joshua 11:4)
- Then the sons of Joseph said; The mountainous region is not enough for us, and there are war chariots with iron scythes among all the Canaanites dwelling in the land of the low plain, both those who are in Beth-shean and its dependent towns and those who are in the low plain of Jezreel. (Joshua 17:16)
- It was then that the hoofs of horses pawed because of dashings upon dashings of his stallions. (Judges 5:22)
- And all this congregation will know that neither with sword nor with spear does Yehowah save, because to Yehowah belongs the battle, and he must give you men into our hand. (1 Samuel 17:47)
- But he took his stand in the middle of the tract and delivered it and kept striking down the Philistines, so that Yehowah performed a great salvation. (2 Samuel 23:12)
- As for Ben-hadad the king of Syria, he collected all his military forces together and also thirty-two kings with him and horses and

chariots, and he proceeded to go up and lay siege to Samaria and fight against it. (1 Kings 20:1)

- Now a certain Naaman, the chief of the army of the king of Syria, had become a great man before his lord and held in esteem, because it was by him that Yehowah had given salvation to Syria, and the man himself had proved to be a valiant, mighty man, though a leper. (2 Kings 5:1)
- Immediately they got up and went fleeing in the evening darkness and leaving their tents and their horses and their asses, the camp just as it was, and they kept fleeing for their soul. (2 Kings 7:7)
- Now, then, at the very time that this letter comes to you there are with you the sons of your lord, and there are with you the war chariots and the horses and a fortified city and the armor. (2 Kings 10:2)
- But he took his stand in the middle of the tract and delivered it, and kept striking down the Philistines, so that Yehowah saved with a great salvation. (1 Chronicles 11:14)
- It paws in the low plain and exults in power, it goes forth to meet armor. (Job 39:21)
- With length of days I shall satisfy him, and I shall cause him to see salvation by me. (Psalms 91:16)
- Because their arrows are sharpened and all their bows are bent. The very hoofs of their horses will have to be accounted as flint itself, and their wheels as a storm wind. (Isaiah 5:28)
- How, then, could you turn back the face of one governor of the smallest servants of my lord, while you, for your part, put your trust in Egypt for chariots and for horsemen? (Isaiah 36:9)
- At the sound of the stamping of the hoofs of his stallions, at the rattling of his war chariots, the turmoil of his wheels, the fathers will actually not turn around to the sons, because of the dropping down of their hands. (Jeremiah 47:3)
- I saw in the night, and, look! A man riding on a red horse, and he was standing still among the myrtle trees that were in the deep place, and behind him there were horses red, bright red, and white. (Zechariah 1:8)
- And I shall certainly cut off the war chariot from Ephraim and the horse from Jerusalem. And the battle bow must be cut off. And he will

actually speak peace to the nations, and his rulership will be from sea to sea and from the River to the ends of the earth. (Zechariah 9:10)

- Against the shepherds my anger has grown hot, and against the goatlike leaders I shall hold an accounting, for Yehowah of armies has turned his attention to his drove, the house of Judah, and has made them like his horse of dignity in the battle. (Zechariah 10:3)
- In that day, is the utterance of Yehowah, I shall strike every horse with bewilderment and its rider with madness, and upon the house of Judah I shall open my eyes, and every horse of the peoples I shall strike with loss of sight. (Zechariah 12:4)
- And I saw, and, look! A white horse, and the one seated upon it had a bow, and a crown was given him, and he went forth conquering and to complete his conquest. (Revelation 6:2)
- And the winepress was trodden outside the city, and blood came out of the winepress as high up as the bridles of the horses, for a distance of a thousand six hundred furlongs. (Revelation 14:20)
