Proverbs 3:5 Trust in Yehowah with all your heart and do not lean upon your own understanding.

[28] - References

- Trust in him at all times, O people. Before him pour out **YOUR heart**. God is a refuge for us. (**Psalms 62:8**)
- Trust in **Yehowah**, **you** people, for all times, for in Yah, **Yehowah** is the Rock of times indefinite. (**Isaiah 26:4**)
- Blessed is the able-bodied man who puts his trust in **Yehowah**, and whose confidence **Yehowah** has become. (**Jeremiah 17:7**)
- He that is trusting in his **own heart** is stupid, but he that is walking in wisdom is the one that will escape. (**Proverbs 28:26**)
- This is what **Yehowah** has said; Let not the wise man brag about himself because of his wisdom, and let not the mighty man brag about himself because of his mightiness. Let not the rich man brag about himself because of his riches. (**Jeremiah 9:23**)
- I well know, O **Yehowah**, that to earthling man his way does not belong. It does not belong to man who is walking even to direct his step. (**Jeremiah 10:23**)
- Let no one be seducing himself; If anyone among **you** thinks he is wise in this system of things, let him become a fool, that he may become wise. (**1 Corinthians 3:18**)
- Upon that the men took some of their provisions, and at the mouth of **Yehowah** they did not inquire. (**Joshua 9:14**)
- And after the death of Joshua it came about that the sons of Israel proceeded to inquire of **Yehowah**, saying; Who of us will go up first to the Canaanites to fight against them? (**Judges 1:1**)

- Then the sons of Israel went up and wept before **Yehowah** until the evening and inquired of **Yehowah**, saying; Shall I again approach for battle against the sons of Benjamin my brother? To this **Yehowah** said; Go up against him. (**Judges 20:23**)
- In those days there was no king in Israel. What was right in his **own** eyes was what each one was accustomed to do. (**Judges 21:25**)
- So I said to myself; Now the Philistines will come down against me at Gilgal, and the face of **Yehowah** I have not softened. So I compelled myself and went offering up the burnt sacrifice. (**1 Samuel 13:12**)
- So the men of the outpost answered Jonathan and his armor-bearer and said; Come on up to us, and we will let **you** know a thing! At once Jonathan said to his armor-bearer; Come up after me, because **Yehowah** will certainly give them into the hand of Israel. (**1 Samuel 14:12**)
- And Saul began to inquire of God; Shall I go down after the Philistines? Will you give them into the hand of Israel? And he did not answer him on that day. (**1 Samuel 14:37**)
- And David proceeded to inquire of **Yehowah**, saying; Shall I go, and must I strike down these Philistines? In turn **Yehowah** said to David; Go, and you must strike down the Philistines and save Keilah. (**1 Samuel 23:2**)
- And David began to inquire of **Yehowah**, saying; Shall I chase after this marauder band? Shall I overtake them? At this he said to him; Go in chase, for you will without fail overtake them, and you will without fail make a deliverance. (**1 Samuel 30:8**)
- At that David inquired of **Yehowah**, but he said; You must not go up. Go around to the rear of them, and you must come against them in front of the baca bushes. (**2 Samuel 5:23**)
- Immediately he went and did according to the word of **Yehowah**, and so went and took up dwelling by the torrent valley of Cherith that is east of the Jordan. (**1 Kings 17:5**)
- However, Jehoshaphat said to the king of Israel; Please, inquire first of all for the word of **Yehowah**. (**2 Chronicles 18:4**)
- Sacrifice the sacrifices of righteousness, and trust in **Yehowah**. (**Psalms 4:5**)

- I will say to **Yehowah**; You are my refuge and my stronghold, my God, in whom I will trust. (**Psalms 91:2**)
- O Israel, trust in **Yehowah**, he is their help and their shield. (**Psalms 115:9**)
- Those trusting in **Yehowah** are like Mount Zion, which cannot be made to totter, but dwells even to time indefinite. (**Psalms 125:1**)
- In the morning cause me to hear your loving-kindness, for in you I have put my trust. Make known to me the way in which I should walk, for to you I have lifted up my soul. (**Psalms 143:8**)
- For your confidence to come to be in **Yehowah** himself I have given you knowledge today, even you. (**Proverbs 22:19**)
- Do not toil to gain riches. Cease from your **own understanding**. (**Proverbs 23:4**)
- When someone righteous turns back from his righteousness and actually does injustice, he must also die for them. (**Ezekiel 33:18**)
- Even for them to ask for mercies on the part of the God of heaven concerning this secret, in order, that they might not destroy Daniel and his companions with the remainder of the wise men of Babylon. (**Daniel 2:18**)
