- Even from the day that I put judges in command over my people Israel, and I will give you rest from all your enemies. And **Yehowah** has told you that a **house** is what **Yehowah** will make for you. (**2 Samuel 7:11**)
- In all your ways take notice of him, and he himself will make your paths straight. (**Proverbs 3:6**)
- Let your kingdom come. Let your will take place, as in heaven, also upon earth. (**Matthew 6:10**)
- He was faithful to the One that made him such, as Moses was also in all the **house** of that One. (**Hebrews 3:2**)
- Instead, **you** ought to say; If **Yehowah** wills, we shall live and also do this or that. (**James 4:15**)
- The blessing of **Yehowah**, that is what makes rich, and he adds no pain with it. (**Proverbs 10:22**)
- For we are God's fellow workers. **You** people are God's field under cultivation, God's building. (**1 Corinthians 3:9**)
- They proceeded to choose new gods. It was then there was war in the gates. A shield could not be seen, nor a lance, among forty thousand in Israel. (**Judges 5:8**)
- **Yehowah** is guarding you. **Yehowah** is your shade on your right hand. (**Psalms 121:5**)

- I, **Yehowah**, am safeguarding her. Every moment I shall water her. In order that no one may turn his attention against her, I shall safeguard her even night and day. (**Isaiah 27:3**)
- And I myself shall become to her, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, a wall of fire all around, and a glory is what I shall become in the midst of her. (**Zechariah 2:5**)
- Roll your works upon **Yehowah** himself and your plans will be firmly established. (**Proverbs 16:3**)
- Upon your walls, O Jerusalem, I **have** commissioned watchmen. All day long and all night long, constantly, let them not keep still. **YOU** who are making mention of **Yehowah**, let there be no silence on **YOUR** part. (**Isaiah 62:6**)
- Against the walls of Babylon lift up a signal. Make strong the watch. Post the watchmen. Make ready those lying in ambush. For **Yehowah** both **has** formed the idea and will certainly do what he **has** spoken against the inhabitants of Babylon. (**Jeremiah 51:12**)
- Son of man, speak to the sons of your people, and you must say to them; As regards a land, in case I bring upon it a sword and the people of the land, one and all, actually take a man and set him as their watchman. (**Ezekiel 33:2**)
- Accordingly **Yehowah** scattered them from there over all the surface of the earth, and they gradually left off building the **city**. (**Genesis 11:8**)
- And you must remember **Yehowah** your God, because he is the giver of power to you to make wealth, in order to carry out his covenant that he swore to your forefathers, as at this day. (**Deuteronomy 8:18**)
- And now, as **Yehowah** is living who **has** firmly established me and keeps me seated upon the throne of David my father and who made a **house** for me just as he **has** spoken, today Adonijah will be put to death. (**1 Kings 2:24**)
- So they came and called to the gatekeepers of the **city** and reported to them, saying; We came into the camp of the Syrians, and, look! There was nobody there nor sound of a man, but only the horses tied and the asses tied and the tents just as they were. (**2 Kings 7:10**)

· Even since the days that I put judges in command over my people Israel. And I shall certainly humble all your enemies. And I tell you, Also a **house Yehowah** will build for you. (**1 Chronicles 17:10**)

· So he said to Judah; Let us build these cities and make walls around and towers, double doors and bars. For us the land is yet available, because we **have** searched for **Yehowah** our God. We **have** searched, and he gives us rest all around. And they went building and proving successful. (**2 Chronicles 14:7**)

· However, Eliezer the son of Dodavahu of Maresha spoke prophetically against Jehoshaphat, saying; Inasmuch as you **have** had partnership with Ahaziah, **Yehowah** will certainly break down your works. Accordingly the ships were wrecked, and they did not retain strength to go to Tarshish. (**2 Chronicles 20:37**)

· However, I replied to them and said to them; The God of the heavens is the One that will grant us success, and we ourselves, his servants, shall get up, and we must build, but **you** yourselves **have** no share, nor just claim, nor memorial in Jerusalem. (**Nehemiah 2:20**)

· So I said to them; The gates of Jerusalem should not be opened until the sun gets hot, and while they are standing by they should shut the doors and bolt them. And station **guards** of the inhabitants of Jerusalem, each one at his own guardpost and each one in front of his own house. (**Nehemiah 7:3**)

· And let the pleasantness of **Yehowah** our God prove to be upon us, and the work of our hands do you firmly establish upon us. Yes, the work of our hands, do you firmly establish it. (**Psalms 90:17**)

· Look! He will not be drowsy nor go to sleep, the that is guarding Israel. (**Psalms 121:4**)

· True wisdom **has** built its **house**, it **has** hewn out its seven pillars. (**Proverbs 9:1**)

· Do not allow your mouth to cause your flesh to sin, neither say before the angel that it was a mistake. Why should the true God become indignant on account of your voice and **have** to wreck the work of your hands? (**Ecclesiastes 5:6**)

· In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah; We **have** a strong **city**. He sets salvation itself for walls and rampart. (**Isaiah 26:1**)

· And their inhabitants will be feeble-handed, they will simply be terrified and ashamed. They must become as vegetation of the field and green tender grass, grass of the roofs and of the terrace before the east wind. (**Isaiah 37:27**)

· They **have** sown wheat, but thorns are what they **have** reaped. They **have worked** themselves sick, they will be of no benefit. And they will certainly be ashamed of the products of **you** people because of the burning anger of Yehowah. (**Jeremiah 12:13**)

· This is what **Yehowah** of armies **has** said; The wall of Babylon, although broad, will without fail be demolished, and her gates, although high, will be set aflame with fire. And the peoples will **have** to toil for simply nothing, and national groups simply for the fire, and they will just tire themselves out. (**Jeremiah 51:58**)

· That are saying; Is not the building of **houses** close at hand? She is the widemouthed cooking pot, and we are the flesh. (**Ezekiel 11:3**)

· For the reason, yes, for the reason that they **have** led my people astray, saying; There is peace! When there is no peace, and there is one that is building a partition wall, but in vain there are those plastering it with whitewash. (**Ezekiel 13:10**)

· Because Edom keeps saying; We **have** been shattered, but we shall return and build the devastated places, this is what **Yehowah** of armies **has** said; They, for their part, will build, but I, for my part, shall tear down. And people will certainly call them the territory of wickedness and the people whom **Yehowah has** denounced to time indefinite. (**Malachi 1:4**)

· And so, under the present circumstances, I say to **you**; Do not meddle with these men, but let them alone, because, if this scheme or this work is from men, it will be overthrown. (**Acts of Apostles 5:38**)
