TURN - THEIR BACK TO GOD

~ Men ··· Unrighteous ··· Turn Their Backs To God - They turned away from me giving me the back and not the face, yes I taught them rising up early and teaching them the good way, but none of them were listening to receive discipline (Jeremiah 32:33) [15] - References

Jeremiah 32:33... And they kept turning to me the back and not the face, though there was a teaching of them, a rising up early and teaching, but there were none of them listening to receive discipline.

[15] - References

- For our fathers have acted unfaithfully and have done what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah our God, so that they left him and turned around their face away from the tabernacle of Yehowah and offered the back of the neck. (2 Chronicles 29:6)
- They are saying to a tree; You are my father. And to a stone; You yourself brought me to birth. But to me they have turned the back of the neck and not the face. And in the time of their calamity they will say; Do rise up and save us! (Jeremiah 2:27)
- But they did not listen, neither did they incline their ear, but they went walking in the counsels in the stubbornness of their bad heart, so that they became backward in direction and not forward. (Jeremiah 7:24)
- But they kept refusing to pay attention, and they kept giving a stubborn shoulder, and their ears they made too unresponsive to hear. (Zechariah 7:11)
- But they were continually making jest at the messengers of the true God and despising his words and mocking at his prophets, until the rage of Yehowah came up against his people, until there was no healing. (2 Chronicles 36:16)
- And now for the reason that you kept doing all these works, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I kept speaking to you, getting up early and speaking, but you did not listen, and I kept calling you, but you did not answer. (Jeremiah 7:13)

- From the thirteenth year of Josiah the son of Amon, the king of Judah, and down to this day, these twenty-three years the word of Yehowah has occurred to me, and I kept speaking to you people, rising up early and speaking, but you did not listen. (Jeremiah 25:3)
- By listening to the words of my servants the prophets, whom I am sending to you, even rising up early and sending them, whom you have not listened to. (Jeremiah 26:5)
- And I kept sending to you all my servants the prophets, rising up early and sending them, saying; Turn back, please, each one from his bad way, and make your dealings good, and do not walk after other gods to serve them. And keep dwelling on the ground that I have given to you and to your forefathers. But you did not incline your ear, nor did you listen to me. (Jeremiah 35:15)
- But they did not listen, nor did they incline their ear to turn back from their badness by not making sacrificial smoke to other gods. (Jeremiah 44:5)
- Due to the fact that they have not listened to my words, is the utterance of Yehowah, that I have sent to them with my servants the prophets, getting up early and sending them. But you have not listened, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 29:19)
- This is what Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Go, and you must say to the men of Judah and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem; Did you not continually receive exhortation to obey my words? is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 35:13)
- Therefore this is what Yehowah, the God of armies, the God of Israel, has said; Here I am bringing upon Judah and upon all the inhabitants of Jerusalem all the calamity that I have spoken against them, for the reason that I have spoken to them but they did not listen, and I kept calling to them but they did not answer. (Jeremiah 35:17)
- So he brought me to the inner courtyard of the house of Yehowah, and, look! At the entrance of the temple of Yehowah, between the porch and the altar, there were about twenty-five men with their backs to the temple of Yehowah and their faces to the east, and they were bowing down to the east, to the sun. (Ezekiel 8:16)
- Then the word of Yehowah occurred to me, saying; (Ezekiel 20:2)
