- And came and dwelt in a city named Nazareth, that there might be fulfilled what was spoken through the **prophets**: He will be called a **Nazarene**. **(Matthew 2:23)**
- The crowds kept telling; This is the **prophet Jesus**, from Nazareth of Galilee! **(Matthew 21:11)**
- A **prophet** I shall raise up for them from the midst of their brothers, like you, and I shall indeed put my **words** in his mouth, and he will certainly speak to them all that I shall command him. **(Deuteronomy 18:18)**
- Now fear seized them all, and they began to glorify **God**, saying; A great **prophet** has been raised up among us, and, God has turned his attention to his people. **(Luke 7:16)**
- This one came to him in the night and **said** to him; Rabbi, we know that you as a teacher have come from **God**, for no one can perform these signs that you perform unless **God** is with him. **(John 3:2)**
- Hence when the men saw the signs he performed, they began to say; This is for a certainty the **prophet** that was to come into the world. **(John 6:14)**
- Men of Israel, hear these **words**; **Jesus** the **Nazarene**, a man publicly shown by **God** to **YOU** through **powerful works** and portents and signs that **God** did through him in **YOUR** midst, just as **YOU** yourselves know. **(Acts of Apostles 2:22)**

- A **prophet** from your own midst, from your brothers, like me, is what Yehowah your **God** will raise up for you, to him **you people** should listen. (**Deuteronomy 18:15**)
- And as regards all the strong hand and all the great awesomeness that Moses exercised **before** the eyes of all Israel. (**Deuteronomy 34:12**)
- Consequently Moses was instructed in all the wisdom of the Egyptians. In fact, he was **powerful** in his **words** and deeds. (**Acts of Apostles 7:22**)
