## TYRE - HAS BEEN DESPOILED - HOWL

Men … Unrighteous … Tyre - Howl for your port of origin has been despoiled, no more will you enter in there. (Isaiah 23:1) [24] -References

**Isaiah 23:1**... The pronouncement of Tyre! Howl, you ships of Tarshish! For it has been despoiled from being a port, from being a place to enter in. From the land of Kittim it has been revealed to them.

## [24] - References

• And upon all the ships of Tarshish and upon all desirable boats. (Isaiah 2:16)

• And as for you, O son of man, raise up concerning Tyre a dirge. (Ezekiel 27:2)

• And you must say to Tyre, O you who are dwelling at the entrances of the sea, the tradeswoman of the peoples for many islands, this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; O Tyre, you yourself have said; I am perfect in prettiness. (Ezekiel 27:3)

• Out of massive trees from Bashan they made your oars. Your prow they made with ivory in cypress wood, from the islands of Kittim. (Ezekiel 27:6)

• The ships of Tarshish were your caravans for your articles of exchange, so that you get filled and become very glorious in the heart of the open sea. (Ezekiel 27:25)

• Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Here I am against you, O Tyre, and I will bring up against you many nations, just as the sea brings up its waves. (Ezekiel 26:3)

• But pass over to the coastlands of the Kittim and see. Yes, send even to Kedar and give YOUR special consideration, and see whether anything like this has happened. (Jeremiah 2:10)

• And all the kings of Tyre and all the kings of Sidon and the kings of the island that is in the region of the sea. (Jeremiah 25:22)

• On account of the day that is coming to despoil all the Philistines, to cut off from Tyre and from Sidon every survivor that was helping.

For Yehowah is despoiling the Philistines, who are the remaining ones from the island of Caphtor. (Jeremiah 47:4)

• And, also, what do you have to do with me, O Tyre and Sidon and all you regions of Philistia? Is it the treatment that you are giving me as a reward? And if you are giving such treatment to me, swiftly, speedily I shall pay back your treatment upon your heads. (Joel 3:4)

• This is what Yehowah has said; On account of three revolts of Tyre, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account of their handing over a complete body of exiles to Edom, and because they did not remember the covenant of brothers. (Amos 1:9)

Look! Yehowah himself will dispossess her, and into the sea he will certainly strike down her military force, and in the fire she herself will be devoured. (Zechariah 9:4)

• For ships belonging to the king were going to Tarshish with the servants of Hiram. Once every three years ships of Tarshish would come in, carrying gold and silver, ivory, and apes and peacocks. (2 Chronicles 9:21)

• With an east wind you wreck the ships of Tarshish. (Psalms 48:7)

• And the sons of Javan were Elishah and Tarshish, Kittim and Dodanim. (Genesis 10:4)

• And there will certainly come against him the ships of Kittim, and he will have to become dejected. And he will actually go back and hurl denunciations against the holy covenant and act effectively, and he will have to go back and will give consideration to those leaving the holy covenant. (Daniel 11:30)

• And there will be ships from the coast of Kittim, and they will certainly afflict Assyria, and they will indeed afflict Eber. But he too will eventually perish. (Numbers 24:24)

• For the king had a fleet of ships of Tarshish on the sea along with Hiram's fleet of ships. Once every three years the fleet of ships of Tarshish would come carrying gold and silver, ivory, and apes and peacocks. (1 Kings 10:22)

• And the sons of Javan were Elishah and Tarshish, Kittim and Rodanim. (1 Chronicles 1:7)

• Cross over your land like the Nile River, O daughter of Tarshish. There is no shipyard any longer. (Isaiah 23:10) • Howl, you ships of Tarshish, for your stronghold has been despoiled. (Isaiah 23:14)

• And you must send them to the king of Edom and to the king of Moab and to the king of the sons of Ammon and to the king of Tyre and to the king of Sidon by the hand of the messengers who are coming to Jerusalem to Zedekiah the king of Judah. (Jeremiah 27:3)

• Out of massive trees from Bashan they made your oars. Your prow they made with ivory in cypress wood, from the islands of Kittim. (Ezekiel 27:6)

• And over you they will certainly let themselves be heard with their voice and will cry out bitterly. And they will bring up dust upon their heads. In the ashes they will wallow. (Ezekiel 27:30)

• And Jonah proceeded to get up and run away to Tarshish from before Yehowah, and he finally came down to Joppa and found a ship going to Tarshish. So he paid its fare and went down into it, in order to go with them to Tarshish from before Yehowah. (Jonah 1:3)

• And Hamath itself will also border upon her, Tyre and Sidon, for she is very wise. (Zechariah 9:2)
