UNRECEPTIVE - AND NOT UNDERSTANDING

Men "Unrighteous "Unreceptive And Not Understanding - Make the heart of this people unreceptive and paste their eyes together and close their ears that they may not get understanding and turn back and get a healing" (Isaiah 6:10) [28] - References

Isaiah 6:10... Make the heart of this people unreceptive, and make their very ears unresponsive, and paste their very eyes together, that they may not see with their eyes and with their ears they may not hear, and that their own heart may not understand and that they may not actually turn back and get healing for themselves.

- As for me, I shall let Pharaoh's heart become obstinate, and I shall certainly multiply my signs and my miracles in the land of Egypt. (Exodus 7:3)
- Also, why should you make Your heart unresponsive just the way Egypt and Pharaoh made their heart unresponsive? Was it not as soon as He dealt severely with them that they proceeded to send them away, and they went their way? (1 Samuel 6:6)
- But as for the house of Israel, they will not want to listen to you, for they are not wanting to listen to me, because all those of the house of Israel are hardheaded and hardhearted. (Ezekiel 3:7)
- To the latter ones an odor issuing from death to death, to the former ones an odor issuing from life to life. And who is adequately qualified for these things? (2 Corinthians 2:16)
- To whom shall I speak and give warning, that they may hear? Look! Their ear is uncircumcised, so that they are unable to pay attention. Look! The very word of Yehowah has become to them a reproach, in which word they can take no delight. (Jeremiah 6:10)
- But they kept refusing to pay attention, and they kept giving a stubborn shoulder, and their ears they made too unresponsive to hear. (Zechariah 7:11)

- For he that practices vile things hates the light and does not come to the light, in order, that his works may not be reproved. (John 3:20)
- For the heart of this people has grown unreceptive, and with their ears they have heard without response, and they have shut their eyes, that they should never see with their eyes and hear with their ears and understand with their heart and turn back, and I should heal them. (Acts of Apostles 28:27)
- If a man should sin against a man, God will arbitrate for him, but if it is against Yehowah that a man should sin, who is there to pray for him? But they would not listen to the voice of their father, because Yehowah was now pleased to put them to death. (1 Samuel 2:25)
- In reply Jesus said to him; Let it be, this time, for in that way it is suitable for us to carry out all that is righteous. Then he quit preventing him. (Matthew 3:15)
- At that Yehowah said to him; Who appointed a mouth for man or who appoints the speechless or the deaf or the clear-sighted or the blind? Is it not I, Yehowah? (Exodus 4:11)
- And yet Yehowah has not given you a heart to know and eyes to see and ears to hear down to this day. (Deuteronomy 29:4)
- For they are a nation on whom counsel perishes, and among them there is no understanding. (Deuteronomy 32:28)
- For their heart you have closed to discretion. That is why you do not exalt them. (Job 17:4)
- Their heart has become unfeeling just like fat. I, for my part, have been fond of your own Law. (Psalms 119:70)
- He is healing the brokenhearted ones, and is binding up their painful spots. (Psalms 147:3)
- Whom will one instruct in knowledge, and whom will one make understand what has been heard? Those who have been weaned from the milk, those moved away from the breasts? (Isaiah 28:9)
- For upon You men Yehowah has poured a spirit of deep sleep, and he closes YOUR eyes, the prophets, and he has covered even YOUR heads, the visionaries. (Isaiah 29:10)

- They have not come to know, nor do they understand, because their eyes have been besmeared so as not to see, their heart so as to have no insight. (Isaiah 44:18)
- His watchmen are blind. None of them have taken note. All of them are speechless dogs, they are not able to bark, panting, lying down, loving to slumber. (Isaiah 56:10)
- Why do you, O Yehowah, keep making us wander from your ways? Why do you make our heart hard against the fear of you? Come back for the sake of your servants, the tribes of your hereditary possession. (Isaiah 63:17)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; There is no cure for your breakdown. Your stroke is chronic. (Jeremiah 30:12)
- But you began to trust in your prettiness and become a prostitute on account of your name and to pour out your acts of prostitution on every passerby, his it came to be. (Ezekiel 16:15)
- And I, I myself, must remember my covenant with you in the days of your youth, and I must establish for you an indefinitely lasting covenant. (Ezekiel 16:60)
- This is why I speak to them by the use of illustrations, because, looking, they look in vain, and hearing, they hear in vain, neither do they get the sense of it. (Matthew 13:13)
- Saying; If you, even you, had discerned in this day the things having to do with peace, but now they have been hid from your eyes. (Luke 19:42)
- He has blinded their eyes and he has made their hearts hard, that they should not see with their eyes and get the thought with their hearts and turn around and I should heal them. (John 12:40)
- But their mental powers were dulled. For to this present day the same veil remains unlifted at the reading of the old covenant, because it is done away with by means of Christ. (2 Corinthians 3:14)
