Men ... Unrighteous ... Violence and Detestable Idols - Have you seen O Son of Man how great a badness the house of Israel is doing by such detestable things and they have filled the land with violence and they offend me again and again by thrusting out their new love, idols gods, to my nose (Ezekiel 8:17) [11] - References

Ezekiel 8:17... And he went on to say to me; Have you seen this, O Son of Man? Is it such a light thing to the house of Judah to do the detestable things that they have done here, that they have to fill the land with violence and that they should offend me again, and here they are thrusting out the shoot to my nose?

- After that God said to Noah; The end of all flesh has come before me, because the earth is full of violence as a result of them, and here I am bringing them to ruin together with the earth. (Genesis 6:13)
- And there was also innocent blood that Manasseh shed in very great quantity, until he had filled Jerusalem from end to end, besides his sin with which he caused Judah to sin by doing what was bad in the eyes of Yehowah. (2 Kings 21:16)
- For the reason that they have left me and have proceeded to make this place unrecognizable and to make sacrificial smoke in it to other gods whom they had not known, they and their forefathers and the kings of Judah, and they have filled this place with the blood of the innocent ones. (Jeremiah 19:4)
- So he said to me; The error of the house of Israel and Judah is very, very great, and the land is filled with bloodshed and the city is full of crookedness, for they have said; Yehowah has left the land, and Yehowah is not seeing. (Ezekiel 9:9)
- And I will give attention to everyone that is climbing upon the plaform in that day, those who are filling the house of their masters with violence and deception. (Zephaniah 1:9)
- They began inciting him to jealousy with strange gods. With detestable things they kept offending him. (Deuteronomy 32:16)

- Do not be wicked overmuch, nor become foolish. Why should you die when it is not your time? (Ecclesiastes 7:17)
- Is it I whom they are offending, is the utterance of Yehowah? Is it not they themselves, for the purpose of shame to their faces? (Jeremiah 7:19)
- On account of all the badness of the sons of Israel and of the sons of Judah that they have done to offend me, they, their kings, their princes, their priests and their prophets, and the men of Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem. (Jeremiah 32:32)
- For Israel and Judah are not widowed from their God, from Yehowah of armies. For the land of those has been full of guilt from the standpoint of the Holy One of Israel. (Jeremiah 51:5)
- Her adversaries have become the head. Those who are her enemies are unconcerned. Because Yehowah himself has brought grief to her on account of the abundance of her transgressions. Her own children have walked captive before the adversary. (Lamentations 1:5)
