Proverbs 11:18.. The wicked one is making false wages, but the one sowing righteousness, true earnings.

[13] - References

- This is the share of the wicked man from God, and the inheritance of the tyrants they will receive from the Almighty himself. (Job 27:13)
- Do not be misled! God is not one to be mocked. For whatever a man is sowing, this he will also reap. (Galatians 6:7)
- Those sowing seed with tears will reap even with a joyful cry. (Psalms 126:5)
- Because he who is sowing with a view to his flesh will reap corruption from his flesh, but he who is sowing with a view to the spirit will reap everlasting life from the spirit. (Galatians 6:8)
- Moreover, the fruit of righteousness has its seed sown under peaceful conditions for those who are making peace. (James 3:18)
- So God dealt well with the midwives, and the people kept growing more numerous and becoming very mighty. (Exodus 1:20)
- For the wicked has praised himself over the selfish longing of his soul, and the one making undue profit has blessed himself he has disrespected Yehowah. (Psalms 10:3)
- Yehowah rewards me according to my righteousness, according to the cleanness of my hands he repays me. (Psalms 18:20)
