- As for Ahithophel, he saw that his counsel had not been acted upon, and he proceeded to saddle an ass and rise up and go off to his house at his own city. Then he gave commands to his household and strangled himself and thus died. So he was buried in the burial place of his forefathers. (2 Samuel 17:23)
- And they proceeded to hang Haman on the stake that he had prepared for Mordecai, and the king's rage itself subsided. (Esther 7:10)
- A pit he has excavated, and he proceeded to dig it, but he will fall into the hole that he went making (Psalms 7:15)
- Let ruin come upon him without his knowing, and let his own net that he hid catch him, with ruin let him fall into it. (Psalms 35:8)
- He is making wars to cease to the extremity of the earth. The bow he breaks apart and does cut the spear in pieces, the wagons he burns in the fire. (Psalms 46:9)
- There he broke the flaming shafts of the bow, the shield and the sword and the battle. (Psalms 76:3)
- The mighty men of the bow are filled with terror, but those that are stumbling do gird on vital energy. (1 Samuel 2:4)
- But when Esther came in before the king he said with the written document; Let his bad scheme that he has schemed against the Jews come back upon his own head, and they hanged him and his sons upon the stake. (Esther 9:25)
