Men … Unrighteous … Wealth For Pillaging - And their wealth must come to be for pillage and their houses a desolate waste, they will build houses but they will not have occupancy and they will plant vineyards but they will not rejoice in the wine from them. (Zephaniah 1:13) [12] - References

Zephaniah 1:13... And their wealth must come to be for pillage and their houses for a desolate waste. And they will build houses, but they will not have occupancy, and they will plant vineyards, but they will not drink the wine of them.

- At this I said; How long, O Yehowah? Then he said; Until the cities actually crash in ruins, to be without an inhabitant, and the houses be without earthling man, and the ground itself is ruined into a desolation. (Isaiah 6:11)
- They will also certainly eat up your harvest and your bread. The men will eat up your sons and your daughters. They will eat up your flocks and your herds. They will eat up your vine and your fig tree. They will shatter with the sword your fortified cities in which you are trusting. (Jeremiah 5:17)
- Will not those claiming interest of you rise up suddenly, and those wake up who are violently shaking you, and you certainly become to them something to pillage? (Habakkuk 2:7)
- Therefore, for the reason that you are extracting farm rent from someone lowly, and the tribute of grain you keep taking from him, houses of hewn stone you have built, but you will not keep dwelling in them, and desirable vineyards you have planted, but you will not keep drinking the wine of them. (Amos 5:11)
- You will become engaged to a woman, but another man will rape her. You will build a house, but you will not dwell in it. You will plant a vineyard, but you will not begin to use it. (Deuteronomy 28:30)

- Vineyards you will plant and certainly cultivate, but you will drink no wine and gather nothing in, because the worm will eat it up. (Deuteronomy 28:39)
- In the day you may carefully fence about the plantation of yours, and in the morning you may cause the seed of yours to sprout, but the harvest will certainly flee in the day of the disease and incurable pain. (Isaiah 17:11)
- Within a year and some days you careless ones will be agitated, because the grape picking will have come to an end but no fruit gathering will come in. (Isaiah 32:10)
- And their houses will certainly be turned over to others for possession, the fields and the wives at the same time. For I shall stretch my hand out against the inhabitants of the land, is the utterance of Yehowah. (Jeremiah 6:12)
- Therefore I shall give their wives to other men, their fields to those taking possession, for, from the least one even to the greatest one, each one is making unjust gain, from the prophet even to the priest, each one is acting falsely. (Jeremiah 8:10)
- Our own hereditary possession has been turned over to strangers, our houses to foreigners. (Lamentations 5:2)
- Therefore I shall turn back and certainly take away my grain in its time and my sweet wine in its season, and I will snatch away my wool and my linen for covering her nakedness. (Hosea 2:9)
