

Micah 1:15~ The dispossessor¹ I shall yet bring to you, O inhabitress of Mareshah. As far as Adullam, the glory of Israel will come.

Footnote: Or, The one taking possession

1· For Yehowah counsels them, that the dispossessor of them from the Promised Land, Yehowah will yet bring upon them there in Mareshah. Even as far as Adullam, the glory of Israel will come, in devastating the land of Judah.

[Question] What does Yehowah God promise to bring upon them, and where?

[Question] How far will this dispossessor come into Judah?

2· Yehowah will bring against you and against your people, and against the house of your father, days such as have not come, since the day of Ephraim's turning away from alongside Judah, namely, the king of Assyria. (Isaiah 7:17)

[Question] What did Yehowah God promise to bring up upon Israel, and what would it be worse than?

3· And Gath and Mareshah and Ziph. (2 Chronicles 11:8)

[Question] What was one of the cities, that Rehoboam rebuilt and fortified?

4· Now in the meantime it came about, that when Judah went down from his brothers, he pitched his tent near a man, an Adulamite, and his name was Hirah. (Genesis 38:1)

[Question] Who did Judah first pitch his tent near to, and what was his ancestry?

5· Zanoah, Adullam and their settlements, Lachish and its fields, Azekah and its dependent towns. And they took up camping from Beer-sheba, clear to the valley of Hinnom. (Nehemiah 11:30)

[Question] What three towns mentioned here, are also mentioned by Nehemiah as being resettled after the exile?

6· And Keilah and Achzib and Mareshah, nine cities and their settlements. (Joshua 15:44)

[Question] What cities are among those captured in the conquest of Canaan by Joshua?

- 7· So David proceeded to go from there, and escape to the cave of **Adullam**, and his brothers and the entire house of his father got to hear of it, and made their way down there to him. (**1 Samuel 22:1**)

[Question] Where did David go to, to hide from Saul?

- 8· And three of the thirty head ones proceeded to go down and **come** at the harvest, to David, at the cave of **Adullam**, and a tent village of the Philistines was encamped in the low plain of the Rephaim. (**2 Samuel 23:13**)

[Question] Where did David go to, to hide from the wrath of Saul against him?

- 9· Later Zerah the Ethiopian went out against them with a military force of a million men, and three hundred chariots, and came as **far** as **Mareshah**. (**2 Chronicles 14:9**)

[Question] How far did the Ethiopians advance against Judah, under Zerah?
