

Micah 2:7~ Is it being said, O house of Jacob; Has the spirit¹ of Yehowah become discontented, or are these his dealings? Do not my own words do good in the case of the one walking uprightly?

Footnote: Or, the active force of Yehowah Hebrew, *ru'ach Yehwah'* See (Genesis 1:2) Footnote Force

1· The people of the house of Jacob had become disheartened in serving their God. Yehowah reveals that he had heard them say; Has the spirit of Yehowah become discontented, or are these his dealings? Yet Yehowah showed, that they felt this way over their own bad deeds, for anyone following his own fine counsel, would find only good, by following after his fine counsel.

[Question] How did the people of Israel feel, and who did they attribute that feeling to?

[Question] Yet why were they feeling that way, and whose fault was it?

2· Hear the word of Yehowah, O house of Jacob, and all you families of the house of Israel. (Jeremiah 2:4)

[Question] What did Jeremiah tell the people to listen to?

3· The Rock, perfect is his activity, for all his ways are justice. A God of faithfulness, with whom there is no injustice, Righteous and upright is he. (Deuteronomy 32:4)

[Question] How did Moses describe the fine qualities of Yehowah God?

4· Why is it that, when I came in, there was no one? When I called, there was nobody answering? Has my hand become in fact, so short, that it cannot redeem, or is there in me, no power to deliver? Look! With my rebuke I dry up the sea, I make rivers a wilderness. Their fish stink due to there being no water, and they die because of thirst. (Isaiah 50:2)

[Question] What did Yehowah God ask his people, to show, that it is their own failings, that keep them apart from their God?

5· The Law of Yehowah is perfect, bringing back the soul. The reminder of Yehowah is trustworthy, making the

inexperienced one wise. (Psalms 19:7)

[Question] What does anyone following the Law Covenant experience?

- 6· For the word of Yehowah is upright, and all his work is in faithfulness. (Psalms 33:4)**

[Question] What is the word of Yehowah God to mankind, and what is manifest in all his works?

- 7· Your words were found, and I proceeded to eat them, and your word becomes to me, the exultation and the rejoicing of my heart, for your name has been called upon me, O Yehowah, God of armies. (Jeremiah 15:16)**

[Question] How did Jeremiah himself feel about the word of Yehowah God?

- 8· He who is walking faultlessly and practicing righteousness and speaking the truth in his heart. (Psalms 15:2)**

[Question] Who will Yehowah God bless?

- 9· And for the upright ones he will treasure up practical wisdom, for those walking in integrity he is a shield. (Proverbs 2:7)**

[Question] What will those upright at heart treasure up?

[Question] What is Yehowah God, to those walking in their integrity?

- 10· At that the king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat; There is still one man through whom to inquire of Yehowah, but I myself certainly hate him, for he is prophesying concerning me, not for good, but, all his days, for bad. He is Micaiah the son of Imlah. However, Jehoshaphat said; Do not let the king say a thing like that. (2 Chronicles 18:7)**

[Question] How did the king of Israel feel about Micaiah, over his previous prophesying?
