

Micah 3:3~

You the ones who have also eaten the organism of my people, and have stripped their very skin from off them, and smashed to pieces their very bones, and crushed them to pieces like what is in a widemouthed pot and like flesh in the midst of a cooking pot.

1· They have been responsible for eating the organism from off of Yehowah God's people, and stripping the skin off of them, and smashing their bones to pieces. They treat the people like mere food for their wicked ways, and use the people to feed the desires of their wicked hearts.

[Question] What did Yehowah God then show, that these wicked leaders were responsible for doing toward his people?

[Question] What are the people like, before their wicked desires?

2· Have none of the practicers of what is hurtful got knowledge, eating up my people as they have eaten bread? They have not called even upon Yehowah. (Psalms 53:4)

[Question] What did they devour the people like, and who did they demonstrate, that they did not know?

3· The fat is what you eat, and with the wool you clothe your own selves. The plump animal is what you slaughter. The flock itself you do not feed. (Ezekiel 34:3)

[Question] How did Ezekiel call these wicked shepherds to account, for how did they treat the sheep?

4· What do you men mean in that you crush my people, and that you grind the very faces of the afflicted ones? Is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord, Yehowah of armies. (Isaiah 3:15)

[Question] How did Yehowah God through Isaiah call them to account, for how they treated his people?

5· Have none of the practicers of what is hurtful got knowledge, eating up my people as they have eaten bread? They have not called even upon Yehowah. (Psalms 14:4)

[Question] What did these practicers of hurtfulness use God's people as?

- 6· There is a generation whose teeth are swords, and whose jawbones are slaughtering knives, to eat up the afflicted ones off the earth, and the poor ones from among mankind. (Proverbs 30:14)

[Question] How did these men use their teeth and their jawbones against his people, devouring them?

- 7· O how the faithful town has become a prostitute! She was full of justice, righteousness itself used to lodge in her, but now, murderers. (Isaiah 1:21)

[Question] What had Jerusalem become then?

[Question] What used to lodge within her gates, but was now gone?

- 8· And the people will actually tyrannize one over the other, even each one over his fellowman. They will storm, the boy against the old man, and the lightly esteemed one against the one to be honored. (Isaiah 3:5)

[Question] How did Isaiah show, that they had lost all respect for righteous ones, and highly esteemed ones among her?

- 9· Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; As regards YOUR slain ones, whom YOU people have put in the midst of her, they are the flesh, and she is the widemouthed cooking pot, and there will be a bringing forth of YOU yourselves out of the midst of her. (Ezekiel 11:7)

[Question] How did Ezekiel illustrate, what would become of Jerusalem and her people, who had behaved this way to righteous ones?
