

Micah 3:8~ **And, on the other hand, I myself have become full of power, with the spirit of Yehowah, and of justice and mightiness, in order to tell to Jacob his revolt, and to Israel his sin.**

1· Micah no doubt felt the things he describes here, yet they have a far greater application to the Messiah, Jesus Christ and his spirit anointed followers, whose hand Yehowah God fills with power from on high, with the spirit of Yehowah God. Likewise his spirit was filled with the justice and mightiness of his God, so as to have the courage and power to tell to Jacob his revolt and to Israel his sin.

[Question] Who no doubt felt this way, but who does a far greater application apply to?

[Question] Why would Yehowah God fill the hand of his Messiah with power through his spirit?

2· And upon him the spirit of Yehowah must settle down, the spirit of wisdom and of understanding, the spirit of counsel and of mightiness, the spirit of knowledge and of the fear of Yehowah. (Isaiah 11:2)

[Question] What would settle down upon this Messianic King of Yehowah God's?

3· Accordingly he answered and said to me; This is the word of Yehowah to Zerubbabel, saying; Not by a military force, nor by power, but by my spirit, Yehowah of armies has said. (Zechariah 4:6)

[Question] How was a type of this king, Zerubbabel, told he would be the means by which he would bring about his purpose?

4· Then Peter, filled with Holy Spirit, said to them; Rulers of the people and older men. (Acts of Apostles 4:8)

[Question] Who did Peter address on Pentecost?

5· And my speech and what I preached were not with persuasive words of wisdom, but with a demonstration of spirit and power. (1 Corinthians 2:4)

[Question] How did Paul and others of the apostles demonstrate, that they had the power of the Holy Spirit backing up their work?

- 6· **Call out full-throated, do not hold back. Raise your voice just like a horn, and tell my people their revolt, and the house of Jacob their sins. (Isaiah 58:1)**

[Question] How was Isaiah to call out to Israel, and what was he to make clean to them, about their relationship to Yehowah God?

- 7· **When he caught sight of many of the Pharisees and Sadducees coming to the baptism, he said to them; You offspring of vipers, who has intimated to you to flee from the coming wrath? (Matthew 3:7)**

[Question] What did John the Baptist not mince words over, when Pharisees came out to the baptism?

- 8· **Obstinate men and uncircumcised in hearts and ears, YOU are always resisting the Holy Spirit, as YOUR forefathers did, so YOU do. (Acts of Apostles 7:51)**

[Question] How did Stephen with spirit and power condemn the religious leaders of Israel, and what did he show that they were just like?

- 9· **But as for me, here I have made you today a fortified city and an iron pillar and copper walls against all the land, toward the kings of Judah, toward her princes, toward her priests, and toward the people of the land. (Jeremiah 1:18)**

[Question] What did Yehowah God tell Jeremiah, that he had made him like, before his rebellious people?

- 10· **You have fooled me, O Yehowah, so that I was fooled. You used your strength against me, so that you prevailed. I became an object of laughter all day long, everyone is holding me in derision. (Jeremiah 20:7)**

[Question] How did Jeremiah come to feel, that Yehowah had been against him, for what had Jeremiah become for following closely Yehowah God's commands to him?

- 11· **Look! I have made your face exactly as hard as their faces and your forehead exactly as hard as their foreheads. (Ezekiel 3:8)**

[Question] What did Yehowah God tell Ezekiel, that he had made his face toward his disobedient people?

- 12· Then the **spirit** of **Yehowah** fell upon me, and he went on to say to me; Say; This is what **Yehowah** has said; **You** people said the right thing, O house of **Israel**, and as regards the things that come up in **YOUR spirit**, I myself **have** known it. (**Ezekiel 11:5**)

[Question] What did Yehowah God tell Ezekiel to say to the men of Israel?

- 13· In answer Peter and the other apostles said; We must obey God as ruler, rather than men. (**Acts of Apostles 5:29**)

[Question] Who did the apostles obey, when faced with stiff opposition and threats?
