

Micah 4:1~

And it must occur in the final part of the days that the mountain of the house of Yehowah will become firmly established above the top of the mountains, and it will certainly be lifted up above the hills, and to it peoples must stream.

1· Then Yehowah God shows, that the fulfillment of his words will come in the final part of the days, though a partial fulfillment did occur in **607 B.C.E.** For then the mountain of the house of Yehowah God, his spirit anointed congregation of 144,000 sons, then acting then as priests and kings toward mankind, would become firmly established above the tops of all other mountains or governments of the earth. To it all of the peoples of the earth would then stream, because then the rulership of Yehowah God will be put on high, and people everywhere will see, that rule by God is very desirable.

[Question] When then, will the fulfillment of his words come about, and when did a partial fulfillment come about?

[Question] What is today the mountain of the house of Yehowah God, and where would it then become firmly established above?

[Question] Who then, would stream to true worship through this divinely appointed priesthood, and what would the people learn through them?

2· **And it must occur in the final part of the days that the mountain of the house of Yehowah will become firmly established above the top of the mountains, and it will certainly be lifted up above the hills, and to it all the nations must stream. (Isaiah 2:2)**

[Question] How had Isaiah also pointed to this outcome, in a similar prophecy?

3· **And he went on to say; Go, Daniel, because the words are made secret and sealed up until the time of the end. (Daniel 12:9)**

[Question] What was Daniel told about the words of his prophecy, and when only would they be understood?

4· **And in the last days, God says; I shall pour out some of my spirit upon every sort of flesh, and YOUR sons and YOUR daughters will prophesy and YOUR young men will see visions and YOUR old men will dream dreams. (Acts of**

Apostles 2:17)

[Question] What did Yehowah God state through Joel, that he would do during the Last Days, and then what would some of his people do?

- 5· They **will** not do any harm or cause any ruin in all my holy **mountain**, because the earth **will certainly** be filled with the knowledge of **Yehowah** as the waters are covering the very sea. (**Isaiah 11:9**)

[Question] What then, would not occur within his holy mountain, and why?

- 6· This is what **Yehowah** has said; **I will** return to Zion and reside in the midst of Jerusalem, and Jerusalem **will certainly** be called the city of trueness, and the **mountain of Yehowah** of armies, the holy mountain. (**Zechariah 8:3**)

[Question] Where then, would Yehowah God return to, and what would New Jerusalem then come to be called?

- 7· So he carried me away in the power of the spirit to a great and lofty **mountain**, and he showed me the holy city Jerusalem, coming down out of heaven from God (**Revelation 21:10**)

[Question] What city did John see coming down from Yehowah God to the earth?

- 8· **You** yourselves also as living stones, are being built up a spiritual **house**, for the purpose of a holy priesthood, to offer up spiritual sacrifices, acceptable to God, through Jesus Christ. (**1 Peter 2:5**)

[Question] What are each one of the spirit anointed Christian sons of God within that spiritual temple, and what do they serve as even now toward mankind, and what do they offer up to God?

- 9· And it **must occur** in the **final part** of the **days** that the **mountain** of the **house** of **Yehowah** **will become firmly established above** the **top** of the **mountains**, and it **will certainly** be, **lifted up above** the **hills**, and to it, all the nations **must stream**. (**Isaiah 2:2**)

[Question] Where will their rulership then become firmly established over, and what do these mountains and hills represent symbolically?

- 10· All the nations whom you have made **will** themselves come, and they **will** bow down before you, O **Yehowah**, and **will** give glory to your name. (**Psalms 86:9**)

[Question] Who will then come and bow down to Yehowah God, and give glory to his name?

- 11· And nations **will certainly** go to your light, and kings to the brightness of your shining forth. (**Isaiah 60:3**)

[Question] Who then, will go to the divine spiritual light emanating from Yehowah God's spirit anointed Christian sons, or Zion?

- 12· Who **will** not really fear you, **Yehowah**, and glorify your name, because you alone are loyal? For all the nations **will** come and worship before you, because your righteous decrees have been made manifest. (**Revelation 15:4**)

[Question] Why then, will all peoples come to fear the name of Yehowah God, and who will come and worship before him in the New Jerusalem?

- 13· Just as we have heard, so we have seen in the city of **Yehowah** of armies, in the city of our God. God himself **will firmly** establish it to time indefinite. (**Psalms 48:8**)

[Question] What then, will the city come to be called, reflecting what about is most famous occupant?

- 14· And I **will** make them and the surroundings of my hill a blessing, and I **will** cause the pouring rain to descend in its time. Pouring rains of blessing there **will** prove to be. (**Ezekiel 34:26**)

[Question] What then will Yehowah God bring forth upon his people, the surroundings of his hill, or Zion?

- 15· In the visions of God he brought me to the land of Israel and gradually set me down upon a very high **mountain**, on which, there was something like the structure of a city to the south. (**Ezekiel 40:2**)

[Question] What vision was Ezekiel shown by Yehowah God, and what did he see to the south of the temple within it?

- 16· Afterwards the sons of Israel **will** come back and **certainly** look for **Yehowah** their God, and for David their king, and

they **will certainly** come quivering to **Yehowah** and to his goodness in the **final part** of the **days**. (**Hosea 3:5**)

[Question] Who will then come back to Yehowah God, and who will they then search out, and how?

- 17· **On this account be glad, YOU heavens and YOU who reside in them! Woe for the earth and for the sea, because the Devil has come down to YOU, having great anger, knowing he has a short period of time. (Revelation 12:12)**

[Question] How should the heavens and the earth come to feel about Yehowah God removing Satan the Devil from the heavens?
