

Micah 4:13~ **Get up and thresh, O daughter of Zion, for your horn I shall change into iron, and your hoofs I shall change into copper, and you will certainly pulverize many peoples, and by a ban you will actually devote to Yehowah their unjust profit, and their resources to the true Lord¹ of the whole earth.**

1· Now Yehowah God addresses his spirit anointed Christian congregation the daughter of Zion, showing that he will empower her, for he will change her horn of authority into iron, and their hoofs into copper, and they will then war against the rebellious peoples of the earth and pulverize many peoples.

[Question] Who then, does Yehowah God bring forth to do this threshing work among the peoples of the earth?

[Question] How does he now show, that he will empower them?

2· Then from the spoils of this wicked old system of things ruled in the past by Satan the Devil, they will devote these spoils by a ban to Yehowah God, and their resources will come to be the possession of the Lord of the whole earth. Then Zion will thresh among the peoples of the earth, searching out the valuable spiritual ones among them, and burning away the worthless chaff.

[Question] What then, will happen to all the spoils of this past wicked system of things, and whose things will they then become?

[Question] What will result from the threshing work then among the peoples of the nations?

3· Look! I have made you a threshing sledge, a new threshing instrument having double-edged teeth. You **will tread down the mountains and crush them, and the hills you **will** make just like the chaff. (Isaiah 41:15)**

[Question] What does Yehowah God state, that he had made his Messiah among mankind, and how will he treat the governments of the earth, while doing this work, for where was threshing always done, and why there?

4· For this is what **Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, has said; The **daughter** of Babylon is like a threshing floor. It**

is the time to tread her down solid. Yet a little while, and the time of the harvest must come for her. (**Jeremiah 51:33**)

[Question] How did Jeremiah prophesy a time of threshing for the people of Babylon, for what time must come for her also?

- 5· For I **will** tread as my bow Judah. The bow I **will** fill with Ephraim, and I **will** awaken your sons, O **Zion**, against your sons, O Greece, and I **will** make you as the sword of a mighty man. (**Zechariah 9:13**)

[Question] Who would Yehowah God use to war against the sons of Greece, as his bow and arrow in the fight?

- 6· But all the silver and the gold and the articles of **copper** and **iron** are something holy to **Yehowah**. Into the treasure of **Yehowah** it should go. (**Joshua 6:19**)

[Question] What were all the captured items of gold and silver devoted to?

- 7· These also King David sanctified to **Yehowah**, together with the silver and the gold, that he had sanctified from all the nations, that he had subdued. (**2 Samuel 8:11**)

[Question] How did King David also sanctify gifts to Yehowah God's house?

- 8· In that time a gift **will** be brought to **Yehowah** of armies, from a people drawn out and scoured, even from a people fear-inspiring everywhere, a nation of tensile strength and of treading down, whose land the rivers have washed away, to the place of the name of **Yehowah** of armies, Mount **Zion**. (**Isaiah 18:7**)

[Question] How did Isaiah show that other peoples then, would bring gifts to Yehowah God's house of worship?

- 9· And her **profit** and her hire must become something holy to **Yehowah**. It **will** not be stored up, nor be laid up, because her hire **will** come to be for those dwelling before **Yehowah**, for eating to satisfaction and for elegant covering. (**Isaiah 23:18**)

[Question] What would the profit of Tyre then become, and what would it be used for?

- 10· Accordingly he said; These are the two anointed ones who are standing alongside the **Lord** of the **whole earth**.
(**Zechariah 4:14**)

[Question] What was Zechariah shown, and what did these two represent?

- 11· So the angel answered and said to me; These are the four spirits of the heavens that are going forth after having taken their station before the **Lord** of the **whole earth**.
(**Zechariah 6:5**)

[Question] What did the four horses and chariots that Zechariah saw represent?

- 12· In that day I shall make the sheiks of Judah like a firepot among trees, and like a fiery torch in a row of newly cut grain, and they must devour on the right hand and on the left, all the **peoples** round about, and Jerusalem must yet be inhabited in her own place, in Jerusalem. (**Zechariah 12:6**)

[Question] What would Yehowah God then make the shieks of Judah like, among all those gathered around against them?

- 13· And he shall shepherd the people with an **iron** rod, so that they **will** be broken to pieces like clay vessels, the same as I have received from my Father. (**Revelation 2:27**)

[Question] How then, will the Messianic king shepherd the nations, and what kind of a rod will he use, depicting what about it? **[See Also "Revelation - An Unveiling" under this verse]**

- 14· You kept on looking until a stone was cut out not by hands, and it struck the image on its feet of iron and of molded clay and crushed them. (**Daniel 2:34**)

[Question] What vision did Nebuchadnezzar see that Daniel interpreted?

- 15· At that time the iron, the molded clay, the copper, the silver and the gold were, all together, crushed, and became like the chaff from the summer threshing floor, and the wind carried them away so that no trace at all was found of them. And as for the stone that struck the image, it became a large mountain and filled the whole earth.

(Daniel 2:35)

[Question] What did the stone that struck the image do to it, and what did the stone then become in the earth?

- 16·** And in the days of those kings, the God of heaven will set up a kingdom that will never be brought to ruin. And the kingdom itself, will not be passed on to any other people. It will crush, and put an end to all these kingdoms, and it itself, will stand to times indefinite. **(Daniel 2:44)**

[Question] What will God then set up in the day of those kings?

[Question] What will that kingdom do to all other kingdoms existing then?

- 17·** Forasmuch as you beheld that out of the mountain a stone was cut not by hands, and that it crushed the iron, the copper, the molded clay, the silver and the gold. The grand God himself has made known to the king what is to occur after this. And the dream is reliable, and the interpretation of it is trustworthy. **(Daniel 2:45)**

[Question] Where was the stone cut out from, and by whom, and what did it do to the image men had made, the world power image?
