

**Micah 4:5~** For all the peoples, for their part, will walk each one in the name of its god,<sup>1</sup> but we, for our part, shall walk in the name of Yehowah<sup>2</sup> our God<sup>3</sup> to time indefinite, even forever.<sup>4</sup>

**1·** The peoples today walk each one in the name of its god, and there is terrible violence and discord among the families of mankind because of this. Then though, they will all walk in the name of Yehowah God forever, the entire earth, for in truth there is only one true God, Yehowah, and this unification will bring about a lasting peace earthwide.

**[Question]** Who did the peoples of the earth walk after today, and what has this caused among men?

**[Question]** Whose name then will all the earth walk in, and what will this unification bring about?

**2·** However, each different nation came to be a maker of its own **god**, which they then deposited in the house of the high places that the Samaritans had made, each different nation, in their cities where they were dwelling. (**2 Kings 17:29**)

**[Question]** What did every nation make for themselves?

**3·** Has a nation exchanged **gods, even** for those that are no **gods**? But my own people have exchanged my glory for what can bring no benefit. (**Jeremiah 2:11**)

**[Question]** What did Israel exchange, for the true God, Yehowah?

**4·** And I **will** make them superior in **Yehowah**, and in his **name** they **will walk** about, is the utterance of Yehowah. (**Zechariah 10:12**)

**[Question]** What would Yehowah God make of those people calling upon his name?

- 5· Then **God** said once more to Moses; This is what you are to say to the sons of Israel, Yehowah the **God** of **YOUR** forefathers, the **God** of Abraham, the **God** of Isaac, and the **God** of Jacob, has sent me to **you**. This is my **name** to time **indefinite**, and this is the memorial of me to generation after generation. (**Exodus 3:15**)

**[Question]** What is the name of the true God, the God of the holy Bible?

- 6· For this **God** is our **God** to time **indefinite, even forever**. He himself **will** guide us until we die. (**Psalms 48:14**)

**[Question]** Who did the Psalmist show would guide him throughout his life?

- 7· I **will** exalt you, O my **God** the King, and I **will** bless your **name** to time **indefinite, even forever**. (**Psalms 145:1**)

**[Question]** How did the Psalmist feel about the glorious name of Yehowah God?

- 8· And **Yehowah** proceeded to drive out all the peoples, **even** the Amorites, dwelling in the land from before us. As for us, too, we shall serve **Yehowah**, because he is our God. (**Joshua 24:18**)

**[Question]** How did Yehowah God prove to his people, that he was their God?

- 9· And they **will** certainly become my people, and I myself shall become their **God**. (**Jeremiah 32:38**)

**[Question]** What will people then become, and what will Yehowah God become to them?

- 10· In order to **walk** worthily of **Yehowah** to the end of fully pleasing him, as **you** go on bearing fruit in every good work, and increasing in the accurate knowledge of **God**. (**Colossians 1:10**)

**[Question]** How should spirit anointed Christians grow in their knowledge of God and his ways?
