

**Micah 5:10~** **And it must occur in that day, is the utterance of Yehowah, that I will cut off your horses from the midst of you, and destroy your chariots.**

**1· Then it will occur in that day, that Yehowah God will take war away from the earth. This he here illustrates by taking away horses from his people, and of destroying their war chariots, for these were the primary means of conducting warfare in Micah's day and time.**

**[Question]** What things then, will Yehowah God take away from the earth, for how were such things used in Micah's day?

**2· Some concerning chariots and others concerning horses, but, as for us, concerning the name of Yehowah our God we shall make mention. (Psalms 20:7)**

**[Question]** Who did the Psalmist show, that he trusted in alone?

**3· There is no king saved by the abundance of military forces, a mighty man himself is not delivered by the abundance of power. (Psalms 33:16)**

**[Question]** Is any king saved through the abundance of military forces, or a mighty man through his own power?

**4· But to the house of Judah I shall show mercy, and I will save them by Yehowah their God, but I shall not save them by a bow or by a sword or by war, by horses or by horsemen. (Hosea 1:7)**

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God show, that he would then show to the house of Judah, and how would he come to save them?

**5· Assyria itself will not save us. Upon horses we shall not ride. And no more shall we say; O our God! To the work of our hands, because it is by you that a fatherless boy is shown mercy. (Hosea 14:3)**

**[Question]** What will the sons of Israel then never trust in again, or give credit to, for their salvation?

**6· And I shall certainly cut off the war chariot from Ephraim and the horse from Jerusalem. And the battle bow must be cut off. And he will actually speak peace to the nations,**

and his rulership **will** be from sea to sea and from the River to the ends of the earth. (**Zechariah 9:10**)

**[Question]** What did Zechariah then prophesy would come forth to Yehowah God's people, and what would his Messiah speak to the nations?

- 7· He is making wars to cease to the extremity of the earth. The bow he breaks apart and does **cut** the spear in pieces, the wagons he burns in the fire. (**Psalms 46:9**)

**[Question]** What will Yehowah God then make cease to the ends of the earth, and how will he do this?

- 8· And he will certainly render judgment among the nations and set matters straight respecting many peoples. And they will have to beat their swords into plowshares and their spears into pruning shears. Nation will not lift up sword against nation, neither will they learn war anymore. (**Isaiah 2:4**)

**[Question]** What will Yehowah God then render among the nations of the earth, and set straight among its peoples?

**[Question]** What will the nations then have to do with their weapons of warfare, and what will they never learn again?

- 9· And he will certainly render judgment among many peoples, and set matters straight respecting mighty nations far away. And they will have to beat their swords into plowshares, and their spears into pruning shears. They will not lift up sword, nation against nation, neither will they learn war anymore. (**Micah 4:3**)

**[Question]** What will Yehowah God then render among peoples and nations?

**[Question]** What will they have to do with their weapons of war, and what will then never learn again after that?
