

**Micah 5:15~** **And in anger and in rage I will execute vengeance upon the nations that have not obeyed.**

**1· Then also, he will execute vengeance and anger upon all of the nations of the earth, that have not followed after his way of peace and righteousness, in truth.**

**[Question]** Who also will Yehowah God execute his anger against them, and why?

**2· To execute vengeance upon the nations, rebukes upon the national groups. (Psalms 149:7)**

**[Question]** What did the Psalmist show, that Yehowah God would execute against the nations?

**3· In a flaming fire, as he brings vengeance upon those who do not know God, and those who do not obey the Good News about our Lord Jesus. (2 Thessalonians 1:8)**

**[Question]** Whom does the Christ bring vengeance upon, and how does he come against them?

**4· Be glad, you nations, with his people, for he will avenge the blood of his servants, and he will pay back vengeance to his adversaries, and will indeed make atonement for the ground of his people. (Deuteronomy 32:43)**

**[Question]** Why are God's servants called upon to be glad, for what things will Yehowah God do in their behalf?

**5· For the day of Yehowah against all the nations is near. In the way that you have done, it will be done to you. Your sort of treatment, will return upon your own head. (Obadiah 1:15)**

**[Question]** Against whom, is the Day of Yehowah to come?

**[Question]** What way, will then be returned to them, and what treatment will then be given to them?

**6· Yehowah is a God exacting exclusive devotion and taking vengeance, Yehowah is taking vengeance, and is disposed to rage. Yehowah is taking vengeance against his adversaries, and he is resentful toward his enemies. (Nahum 1:2)**

**[Question]** What does Yehowah God exact from his people, and what does he express toward his enemies?
