5' Glory in the heights above to God, and upon earth peace among men of goodwill. (Luke 2:14)

[Question] What did the angels proclaim, that his coming birth would bring, to men of goodwill on earth?

6. Even therefore, look! Yehowah is bringing up against them the mighty and the many waters of the River, the king of Assyria and all his glory. And he will certainly come up over all his streambeds, and go over all his banks (Isaiah 8:7)

[Question] Who did Isaiah prophesy would come up against Israel and even Judah?

7. And he must pass through the sea with distress, and in the sea he must strike down the waves, and all the depths of the Nile must dry up. And the pride of Assyria must be brought down, and the very scepter of Egypt will depart. (Zechariah 10:11)
