

Micah 6:1~ Hear, please, **you** people, what Yehowah is saying.¹ Get up, conduct a legal case with the mountains, and may the hills hear your voice.

Footnote: Hear, then, Yehowah's word; Yehowah said LXX

1· So Yehowah calls for people to come together to listen to what he is saying. He has a legal case with the mountains, the governments of this earth, and also with the hills, the lesser governmental groupings under them. They have been entrusted with the sovereignty of the earth, a stewardship in his behalf, and he has a legal case with them over how they have exercised their stewardship of his footstool.

[Question] What does Yehowah God call forth his people to hear, for who is he coming against in a legal case?

[Question] How have they been like a steward over his earth, and why does he have a legal case against them?

2· Hear, **you** people, and give ear. Do not be haughty, for Yehowah himself has spoken. (**Jeremiah 13:15**)

[Question] How should men not behave, before this glorious God?

3· God, who long ago spoke on many occasions and in many ways to our forefathers by means of the prophets. (**Hebrews 1:1**)

[Question] How did Yehowah God many times give forth his voice to mankind?

4· He calls to the heavens above, and to the earth, so as to execute judgment on his people. (**Psalms 50:4**)

[Question] Whom does Yehowah God call out too, so as to give forth his judgments?

5· And now, O **you** inhabitants of Jerusalem and **you** men of Judah, please judge between me and my vineyard. (**Isaiah 5:3**)

[Question] Whom did Yehowah God call to judge between him and his vineyard Israel?

6· And as for you, O son of man, prophesy concerning the

mountains of Israel, and you must say; **O mountains** of Israel, **hear** the word of **Yehowah**. (**Ezekiel 36:1**)

[Question] Who did Yehowah God tell Ezekiel to prophesy to, and so what must these mountains represent?

7· O mountains, that **you** went skipping about like rams, **O hills**, like lambs? (**Psalms 114:6**)

[Question] How will the mountains of this earth react to this powerful word of Yehowah God, when he comes forth in judgment of them?

8· So he called him and said to him; What is this I hear about you? Hand in the account of your stewardship, for you can no longer manage the house. (**Luke 16:2**)

[Question] How did Jesus give an illustration of an unrighteous steward, and what was he called forth to do before his master?
