

**Micah 6:3~ O my people, what have I done to you? And in what way have I tired you out? Testify against me.**

**1· So Yehowah God asks his people Israel, what he has done to them and how has he tired them out, for they have left him, and refuse to listen to him anymore. He thus asks them to state their reasons, and make their case against him plain, if they have ones.**

**[Question]** How does Yehowah God now ask his people, to show why they have left him?

**2· Hear, O my people, and I will bear witness **against** you, O Israel, if you will listen to me. (**Psalms 81:8**)**

**[Question]** What did the Psalmist show, that Yehowah God would do against his people, if they would even listen to him?

**3· This is **what** Yehowah has said; What **have** **YOUR** fathers found in me that was unjust, so that they **have** become far off from me, and they kept walking after the vain idol, and becoming vain themselves? (**Jeremiah 2:5**)**

**[Question]** How did Jeremiah plead with Israel to testify as to what had caused their estrangement from Yehowah God?

**4· Let the nations all be collected together at one place, and let national groups be gathered together. Who is there among them that can tell this? Or can they cause us to hear even the first things? Let them furnish their witnesses, that they may be declared righteous, or let them hear and say; It is the truth! (**Isaiah 43:9**)**

**[Question]** What did Isaiah invite the national groups who worship idols to bring forth testimony about, if they could find any?

**5· Never may that happen! But let God be found true, though every man be found a liar, even as it is written: That you might be proved righteous in your words, and might win when you are being judged. (**Romans 3:4**)**

**[Question]** How should men view Yehowah God's word and promises in respect to their own?

**6· In case you should pass through the waters, I will be with**

**you, and through the rivers, they will not flood over you. In case you should walk through the fire, you will not be scorched, neither will the flame itself singe you. (Isaiah 43:2)**

**[Question]** How did Isaiah show, what a faithful God Yehowah is?

- 7· And you have said; Look! What a weariness! And you have caused a sniffing at it, Yehowah of armies has said. And you have brought something torn away, and the lame one, and the sick one, yes, you have brought it as a gift. Can I take pleasure in it at YOUR hand? Yehowah has said. (Malachi 1:13)**

**[Question]** How did the Israelites show their utter contempt for Yehowah God and his true worship?

**[Question]** Are not the people of Christendom doing the same when they wear a t-shirt advertising the Kingdom, but refuse to witness publicly about the words of faith and truth in the Bible?
