1· When the day finally arrives to again build up Zion, the day for re-erecting her stone walls, at that day, the decree against her will be far away, something from her distant past, for now she will be forgiven for her sins of the past.

[Question] Where will the decree to destroy Zion be, when her walls start to be rebuilt?

2· Finally I said to them; You are seeing the bad plight in which we are, how Jerusalem is devastated and its gates have been burned with fire. Come and let us rebuild the wall of Jerusalem, that we may no longer continue to be a reproach. (Nehemiah 2:17)

3· In your goodwill, do deal well with Zion, may you build the walls of Jerusalem. (Psalms 51:18)
