

Micah 7:16~ Nations will see and become ashamed of all their mightiness. They will put their hand upon their mouth, their very ears will become deaf.

1· Then the nations of the earth will see his hand in the regathering of his people Israel, and they will become ashamed of their own heavy-handedness, and oppression by power over the people of the land. They will put the hand to the mouth, remaining silent, and their ears will become deaf, for they will be struck with awe, at what Yehowah then does for his people.

[Question] Who will he then expose his mighty hand to, by doing what?

[Question] How then, will the nations come to see their past actions against his people?

[Question] How will they come to feel at seeing his mighty saving acts for his people?

2· At that time our mouth came to be filled with laughter, and our tongue with a joyful cry. At that time, they proceeded to say among the nations; Yehowah has done a great thing in what he has done with them. (Psalms 126:2)

[Question] How does the Psalmist show, how Yehowah God's people will feel then, and what will they express joyously?

3· O Yehowah, your hand has become high, but they do not behold it. They will behold and be ashamed at the zeal for your people. Yes, the very fire for your own adversaries will eat them up. (Isaiah 26:11)

[Question] Whose hand is raised on high even now, to express his anger against this system of things, yet do men readily see it?

[Question] What will eat up all of God's adversaries?

4· And as regards their works and their thoughts, I am coming, in order to collect all the nations and tongues together, and they will have to come and see my glory. (Isaiah 66:18)

[Question] What is Yehowah God calling the nations to account for, and what will they then have to come and see?

5· Princes themselves restrained words, and the palm they

would **put** upon their **mouth**. (**Job 29:9**)

[Question] How did Job show, that their mighty ones would become ashamed before his glory?

- 6· He **will** likewise startle many nations. At him kings **will** shut their **mouth**, because what had not been recounted to them, they **will** actually **see**, and to what they had not heard, they must turn their consideration. (**Isaiah 52:15**)

[Question] How will Yehowah God's rising up for his covenant people affect nations?

[Question] Why will they then be startled at what they see?
