

Micah 7:17~ They will lick up dust like the serpents, like reptiles of the earth they will come in agitation, out of their bulwarks. To Yehowah our God¹ they will come quivering, and they will be afraid of you.

Footnote: Our God Hebrew, 'Elo·heh'nu

1· Then they will come to lick the dust like serpents, and like reptiles of the earth they will come in agitation out from their hiding places. Then to Yehowah our God they will come quivering, and they will learn then, to rightly fear this glorious and mighty one, who is God alone.

[Question] How will men then come out of their hiding places quivering to Yehowah God?

[Question] How will they then come to fear and respect Yehowah God, as they should always have done?

2· Before him the inhabitants of waterless regions will bow down, and his very enemies will lick the dust itself. (Psalms 72:9)

[Question] How then, will his enemies react to his glorious power, and where will his enemies reside relative to him?

3· And kings must become caretakers for you, and their princesses nursing women for you. With faces to the earth they will bow down to you, and the dust of your feet they will lick up, and you will have to know that I am Yehowah, of whom those hoping in me, will not be ashamed. (Isaiah 49:23)

[Question] What turnaround will then occur?

4· Foreigners themselves will fade away, and they will come quaking out from their bulwarks. (Psalms 18:45)

[Question] Who then, will fade away, and from where will men come forth to worship Yehowah God?

5· And she went on to say to the men; I do know that Yehowah will certainly give you the land, and that the fright of you has fallen upon us, and that all the inhabitants of the land have become disheartened because of you. (Joshua 2:9)

[Question] How did the men of Canaan come to feel when Israel entered into their land, as expressed by Rahab?

- 6· And she **will** certainly become to me a name of exultation, a praise and a beauty toward all the nations of the **earth**, who **will** hear of all the goodness that I am rendering to them. And they **will** certainly be in dread and be agitated, on account of all the goodness, and on account of all the peace, that I am rendering to her. (**Jeremiah 33:9**)

[Question] What then, will Zion become before her God in all the earth?

[Question] How then, will the nations of the earth come to feel as they see how he treats Zion, and her sons?

- 7· And **Yehowah God** proceeded to say to the serpent; Because you have done this thing, you are the cursed one **out** of all the domestic animals, and **out** of all the wild beasts of the field. Upon your belly you **will** go, and **dust** is what you **will** eat, all the days of your life. (**Genesis 3:14**)

[Question] Where did the serpent have to reside, because of his rebellion to Yehowah God?

- 8· As for any creature that goes upon the belly, and any creature that goes on all fours, or any great number of feet of all the swarming creatures that swarm upon the **earth**, **you** must not eat them, because they are a loathsome thing. (**Leviticus 11:42**)

[Question] What were all creatures whose bellies touched the earth as they went forth, to the Israelites?

- 9· Foreigners themselves **will** fade away, and they **will come** quaking **out** from their **bulwarks**. (**2 Samuel 22:46**)

[Question] Whose hearts then will fade away, and where will they come out from in fear of the true God Yehowah?
