Zephaniah 1:18" Neither their silver nor their gold will be able to deliver them in the day of Yehowah's fury, but by the fire of his zeal the whole earth will be devoured, because he will make an extermination, indeed a terrible one, of all the inhabitants of the earth.

- Valuable things will be of no benefit on the day of fury, but righteousness itself will deliver from death. (Proverbs 11:4)
- In that day the earthling man will throw his worthless gods of silver and his valueless gods of gold that they had made for him to bow before to the shrewmice and to the bats. (Isaiah 2:20)
- Into the streets they will throw their very silver, and an abhorrent thing their own gold will become. Neither their silver nor their gold will be able to deliver them in the day of Yehowah's fury. Their souls they will not satisfy, and their intestines they will not fill, for it has become a stumbling block causing their error. (Ezekiel 7:19)
- Come, now, you rich men, weep, howling over your miseries that are coming upon you. (James 5:1)
- For a fire has been ignited in my anger and it will burn down to Sheol, the lowest place, and it will consume the earth and its produce and will set ablaze the foundations of mountains. (Deuteronomy 32:22)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said, Look! My anger and my rage are being poured forth upon this place, upon mankind and upon domestic animal, and upon the tree of the field and upon the fruitage of the ground, and it must burn, and it will not be extinguished. (Jeremiah 7:20)
- Therefore keep yourselves in expectation of me, is the utterance of Yehowah, till the day of my rising up to the booty, for my judicial decision is to gather nations, for me to collect together kingdoms, in order to pour out upon them my denunciation, all

- my burning anger, for by the fire of my zeal all the earth will be devoured. (Zephaniah 3:8)
- For this is what Yehowah has said; A desolate waste is what the whole land will become, and shall I not carry out a sheer extermination? (Jeremiah 4:27)
- How long, O Yehowah, will you be incensed? Forever? How long will your ardor burn just like fire? (Psalms 79:5)
- The treasures of the wicked one will be of no benefit, but righteousness is what will deliver from death. (Proverbs 10:2)
- In the fury of Yehowah of armies the land has been set afire, and the people will become as food for the fire. No one will show compassion even on his brother. (Isaiah 9:19)
- O house of David, this is what Yehowah has said; Every morning render sentence in justice, and deliver the one being robbed out of the hand of the defrauder, that my rage may not go forth just like a fire and actually burn and there be no one to extinguish it because of the badness of YOUR dealings. (Jeremiah 21:12)
- The time must come, the day must arrive. As regards the buyer, let him not rejoice, and as regards the seller, let him not go into mourning, for there is hot feeling against all its crowd. (Ezekiel 7:12)
