[5] - References:

- This is what **Yehowah** has said; Here I am bringing calamity upon this place and upon its inhabitants, even all the words of the book that the king of Judah has read. (**2 Kings 22:16**)
- At this I said; How long, O Yehowah? Then he said; Until the cities actually crash in ruins, to be **without** an inhabitant, and the houses be **without** earthling man, and the ground itself is ruined into a desolation. (**Isaiah 6:11**)
- Be corrected, O Jerusalem, that my soul may not turn away disgusted from you, that I may not set you as a desolate waste, a land not inhabited. (**Jeremiah 6:8**)
- And the land must become a desolate waste on account of its inhabitants, because of the fruit of their dealings. (**Micah 7:13**)
