Zephaniah 1:6... And those who are drawing back from following Yehowah and who have not sought Yehowah and have not inquired of him.

[13] - References:

- I do regret that I have caused Saul to reign as king, because he has turned back from following me, and my words he has not carried out. And it was distressing to Samuel, and he kept crying out to Yehowah all night long. (1 Samuel 15:11)
- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They have left Yehowah, they have treated the Holy One of Israel with disrespect, they have turned backwards. (Isaiah 1:4)
- That is why Yehowah will not rejoice even over their young men, and upon their fatherless boys and upon their widows he will have no mercy, because all of them are apostates and evildoers and every mouth is speaking senselessness. In view of all this his anger has not turned back, but his hand is stretched out still. (Isaiah 9:17)
- Because there are two bad things that my people have done. They have left even me, the source of living water, in order to hew out for themselves cisterns, broken cisterns, that cannot contain the water. (Jeremiah 2:13)
- Beware, brothers, for fear there should ever develop in any one of you a wicked heart lacking faith by drawing away from the living God. (Hebrews 3:12)
- But my righteous one will live by reason of faith, and, If he shrinks back, my soul has no pleasure in him. (Hebrews 10:38)
- As for Yehowah, he has looked down from heaven itself upon the sons of men, to see whether there exists anyone having insight, anyone seeking Yehowah. (Psalms 14:2)
- But you have not called even me, O Jacob, because you have grown weary of me, O Israel. (Isaiah 43:22)
- There is no one that has any insight, there is no one that seeks for God. (Romans 3:11)

- They have all of them turned back, they are all alike corrupt, there is no one doing good, not even one. (Psalms 53:3)
- I shall not set in front of my eyes any good-for-nothing thing. The doing of those who fall away I have hated, it does not cling to me. (Psalms 101:3)
- And upon every high tower and upon every fortified wall. (Isaiah 2:15)
- Pour out your rage upon the nations who have ignored you, and upon the families who have not called even upon your name. For they have eaten up Jacob. Yes, they have eaten him up, and they keep at exterminating him, and his abiding place they have desolated. (Jeremiah 10:25)
