

**Zephaniah 1:6** And those who are drawing back from following Yehowah and who have not sought Yehowah and have not inquired of him.

[13] - References:

- I do regret that I **have** caused Saul to reign as king, because he has turned **back** from **following** me, and my words he has not carried out. And it was distressing to Samuel, and he kept crying out to **Yehowah** all night long. (**1 Samuel 15:11**)
- Woe to the sinful nation, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They **have** left **Yehowah**, they **have** treated the Holy One of Israel with disrespect, they **have** turned backwards. (**Isaiah 1:4**)
- That is why **Yehowah** will not rejoice even over their young men, and upon their fatherless boys and upon their widows he will **have** no mercy, because all of them are apostates and evildoers and every mouth is speaking senselessness. In view of all this his anger has not turned **back**, but his hand is stretched out still. (**Isaiah 9:17**)
- Because there are two bad things that my people **have** done. They **have** left even me, the source of living water, in order to hew out for themselves cisterns, broken cisterns, that cannot contain the water. (**Jeremiah 2:13**)
- Beware, brothers, for fear there should ever develop in any one of **you** a wicked heart lacking faith by drawing away from the living God. (**Hebrews 3:12**)
- But my righteous one will live by reason of faith, and, If he shrinks **back**, my soul has no pleasure in **him**. (**Hebrews 10:38**)
- As for **Yehowah**, he has looked down from heaven itself upon the sons of men, to see whether there exists anyone having insight, anyone seeking **Yehowah**. (**Psalms 14:2**)
- But you **have** not called even me, O Jacob, because you **have** grown weary of me, O Israel. (**Isaiah 43:22**)
- There is no one that has any insight, there is no one that seeks for God. (**Romans 3:11**)

- They **have** all of them turned **back**, they are all alike corrupt, there is no one doing good, not even one. (**Psalms 53:3**)
- I shall not set in front of my eyes any good-for-nothing thing. The doing of those who fall away I **have** hated, it does not cling to me. (**Psalms 101:3**)
- And upon every high tower and upon every fortified wall. (**Isaiah 2:15**)
- Pour out your rage upon the nations who **have** ignored you, and upon the families who **have** not called even upon your name. For they **have** eaten up Jacob. Yes, they **have** eaten him up, and they keep at exterminating him, and his abiding place they **have** desolated. (**Jeremiah 10:25**)
