[5] - References:

- Sanctify a time of fasting. Call **together** a solemn assembly. Gather **together** the older men, all the inhabitants of the land, to the house of Yehowah **YOUR** God, and cry to Yehowah for aid. (**Joel 1:14**)
- Gather the people **together**. Sanctify a congregation. Collect the old men **together**. Gather children and those sucking the breasts **together**. Let the bridegroom go forth from his interior room, and the bride from her nuptial chamber. (**Joel 2:16**)
- Woe to the sinful **nation**, the people heavy with error, an evildoing seed, ruinous sons! They have left Yehowah. They have treated the Holy One of Israel with disrespect. They have turned backwards. (**Isaiah 1:4**)
- Did they feel **shame** because it was something detestable that they had done? For one thing, they positively do not feel any **shame**, for another thing, they have not come to know even how to feel humiliated. Therefore they will fall among those who are falling, in the time that I must hold an accounting with them they will stumble, Yehowah has said. (**Jeremiah 6:15**)
- Yehowah was righteous in the midst of her, he would do no unrighteousness. Morning by morning he kept giving his own judicial decision. At daylight it did not prove lacking. But the unrighteous one was knowing no **shame**. (**Zephaniah 3:5**)
