Zephaniah 2:4" For, as regards Gaza, an abandoned city is what she will become, and Ashkelon is to be a desolate waste. As regards Ashdod, at high noon they will drive her out, and as regards Ekron, she will be uprooted.

- And I will cut off the inhabitant from Ashdod, and the holder of the scepter from Ashkelon, and I will turn my hand back upon Ekron, and the remaining ones of the Philistines must perish, the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said. (Amos 1:8)
- Nor of the pestilence that walks in the gloom, nor of the destruction that despoils at midday. (Psalms 91:6)
- To me their widows have become more numerous than the sand grains of the seas. I will bring for them, upon mother, young

- man, the despoiler at midday. I will cause to fall upon them suddenly excitement and disturbances. (Jeremiah 15:8)
