- And it must occur in that day that **Yehowah will** again offer his hand, a second time, to acquire the remnant of his people who **will** remain over from Assyria and from Egypt and from Pathros and from Cush and from Elam and from Shinar and from Hamath and from the islands of the sea. (**Isaiah 11:11**)
- For this is what **Yehowah** has said; **CRY out** loudly to Jacob with rejoicing, and **CRY** shrilly at the head of nations. **PUBLISH** it. **GIVE** praise and **SAY**, Save, O **Yehowah**, your people, the remnant of Israel. (**Jeremiah 31:7**)
- I shall positively **gather** Jacob, all of you, I shall without fail collect the **remaining ones** of Israel together. In unity I shall set them, like a flock in the pen, like a drove in the midst of its pasture, they **will** be noisy with men. (**Micah 2:12**)
- And I shall **certainly** make her that was limping a remnant, and her that was removed far off a mighty nation, and **Yehowah will** actually rule as king over them in Mount Zion, from now on and into time indefinite. (**Micah 4:7**)
- And Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Jehozadak the High Priest, and all the **remaining ones** of the people began to listen to the voice of **Yehowah** their **God**, and to the words of Haggai the prophet, as **Yehowah** their **God** had sent him, and the people began to fear because of **Yehowah**. (**Haggai 1:12**)
- Be in severe pains and burst forth, O daughter of Zion, like a woman giving birth, for now you **will** go forth from a town, and you **will** have to reside in the field. And you **will** have to come as far as to Babylon. There you **will** be delivered. There **Yehowah will** buy you **back out** of the palm of your enemies. (**Micah 4:10**)

- Blessed be **Yehowah** the **God** of Israel, because he has turned his **attention** and performed deliverance toward his people. (**Luke 1:68**)
- When **Yehowah** gathered **back** the **captive ones** of Zion, we became like those who were dreaming. (**Psalms 126:1**)
- And I myself shall collect together the remnant of my sheep **out** of all the lands to which I had dispersed them, and I **will** bring them **back** to their pasture ground, and they **will certainly** be fruitful and **become** many. (**Jeremiah 23:3**)
- And I **will** let myself be found by **YOU**, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. And I **will gather** **YOUR** body of **captives** and collect **YOU** together **out** of all the nations and **out** of all the places to which I have dispersed **you**, is the utterance of **Yehowah**. And I **will** bring **you back** to the place from which I caused **you** to go into exile. (**Jeremiah 29:14**)
- And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, is the utterance of **Yehowah**, and do not be struck with terror, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far off and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob **will certainly** return and be free of disturbance and be at ease, and there **will** be no one causing trembling. (**Jeremiah 30:10**)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord **Yehowah** has said; Now is when I shall bring **back** the **captive ones** of Jacob and actually have mercy upon all the **house** of Israel, and I **will** show exclusive devotion for my holy name. (**Ezekiel 39:25**)
- And I **will gather back** the **captive ones** of my people Israel, and they **will** actually build the desolated cities and inhabit them, and plant vineyards and drink the wine of them, and make gardens and eat the fruit of them. (**Amos 9:14**)
- At that time I shall bring **YOU** people in, even in the time of my collecting **YOU** together. For I shall make **YOU** people to be a name and a praise among all the peoples of the earth, when I **gather back** **YOUR captive ones** before **YOUR** eyes, **Yehowah** has said. (**Zephaniah 3:20**)
- And in the second year of their coming to the **house** of the true **God** at Jerusalem, in the second month, Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel and Jeshua the son of Jehozadak and the rest of their brothers, the priests and the Levites, and all those who had come

- out** of the captivity to Jerusalem started, and they now put in positions the Levites from twenty years of age upward to act as supervisors over the work of the **house** of **Yehowah**. (**Ezra 3:8**)
- **The cities of Aroer that have been left behind **become** mere places for droves, where they actually **lie** down, with no one to make them tremble. (**Isaiah 17:2**)**
 - **And as for you, do not be afraid, O my servant Jacob, and do not be terror-stricken, O Israel. For here I am saving you from far away and your offspring from the land of their captivity. And Jacob **will certainly** return and have no disturbance and be at ease and without anyone causing trembling. (**Jeremiah 46:27**)**
