Zephaniah 2:9" Therefore, as I am alive, is the utterance of Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, Moab herself will become just like Sodom, and the sons of Ammon like Gomorrah, a place possessed by nettles, and a salt pit, and a desolate waste, even to time indefinite. The remaining ones of my people will plunder them, and the remnant of my own nation will take possession of them.

- And, on the other hand, as I live, all the earth will be filled with the glory of Yehowah. (Numbers 14:21)
- Raise your eyes all around and see. They have all of them been collected together. They have come to you. As I am living, is the utterance of Yehowah, with all of them you will clothe yourself just as with ornaments, and you will bind them on yourself like a bride. (Isaiah 49:18)
- Yehowah of armies, like Tabor among the mountains and like Carmel by the sea he will come in. (Jeremiah 46:18)
- For it is written: As I live, says Yehowah, to me every knee will bend down, and every tongue will make open acknowledgment to God. (Romans 14:11)
- Then Yehowah made it rain sulphur and fire from Yehowah, from the heavens, upon Sodom and upon Gomorrah. (Genesis 19:24)
- And in Moab I shall execute acts of judgment, and they will have to know that I am Yehowah. (Ezekiel 25:11)
- This is what Yehowah has said; On account of three revolts of Moab, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account of his burning the bones of the king of Edom for lime. (Amos 2:1)
- Son of man, set your face toward the sons of Ammon and prophesy against them. (Ezekiel 25:2)
- This is what Yehowah has said; On account of three revolts of the sons of Ammon, and on account of four, I shall not turn it back, on account of their slitting open the pregnant women of Gilead, for the purpose of widening out their own territory. (Amos 1:13)

- Sulphur and salt and burning, so that its whole land will not be sown, nor sprout, nor will any vegetation spring up in it, like the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah, Admah and Zeboiim, which Yehowah overthrew in his anger and in his wrath. (Deuteronomy 29:23)
- And Babylon, the decoration of kingdoms, the beauty of the pride of the Chaldeans, must become as when God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah. (Isaiah 13:19)
- Just as with God's overthrow of Sodom and of Gomorrah and of her neighbor towns, is the utterance of Yehowah, no man will dwell there, nor will the son of mankind reside in her as an alien. (Jeremiah 50:40)
- As regards Egypt, a desolate waste it will become, and as regards Edom, a wilderness of desolate waste it will become, because of the violence to the sons of Judah, in whose land they shed innocent blood. (Joel 3:19)
- So too Sodom and Gomorrah and the cities about them, after they in the same manner as the foregoing ones had committed fornication excessively and gone out after flesh for unnatural use, are placed before us as a warning example by undergoing the judicial punishment of everlasting fire. (Jude 1:7)
- And the remaining ones of Jacob must become among the nations, in the midst of many peoples, like a lion among the beasts of a forest, like a maned young lion among droves of sheep, which, when it actually passes through, certainly both tramples down and tears in pieces, and there is no deliverer. (Micah 5:8)
- So he went ahead overthrowing these cities, even the entire District and all the inhabitants of the cities and the plants of the ground. (Genesis 19:25)
- As for the younger, she too gave birth to a son and then called his name Benammi. He is the father of the sons of Ammon, to this day. (Genesis 19:38)
- And rejoicing and joyfulness have been taken away from the orchard, and in the vineyards there is no joyful crying out, there is no shouting done. No wine in the presses does the treader tread out. Shouting I have caused to cease. (Isaiah 16:10)

- And now Yehowah has spoken, saying; Within three years, according to the years of a hired laborer, the glory of Moab must also be disgraced with much commotion of every sort, and those who remain over will be a trifling few, not mighty. (Isaiah 16:14)
- At evening time, why, look! There is sudden terror. Before morning, it is no more. This is the share of those pillaging us, and the lot belonging to those plundering us. (Isaiah 17:14)
- For the hand of Yehowah will settle down on this mountain, and Moab must be trodden down in its place as when a straw heap is trodden down in a manure place. (Isaiah 25:10)
- On her dwelling towers thorns must come up, nettles and thorny weeds in her fortified places, and she must become an abiding place of jackals, the courtyard for the ostriches. (Isaiah 34:13)
- And he will certainly become like a solitary tree in the desert plain and will not see when good comes, but he must reside in parched places in the wilderness, in a salt country that is not inhabited. (Jeremiah 17:6)
- Give a road mark to Moab, You people, for at the falling in ruins she will go forth, and her very cities will become a mere object of astonishment, with no one dwelling in them. (Jeremiah 48:9)
- And judgment itself has come to the land of level country, to Holon and to Jahaz and against Mephaath. (Jeremiah 48:21)
- Therefore, look! There are days coming, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will cause the alarm signal of war to be heard even against Rabbah of the sons of Ammon, and she will certainly become a mound of a desolate waste, and her dependent towns themselves will be set aflame in the very fire. And Israel will actually take possession of those in possession of him, Yehowah has said. (Jeremiah 49:2)
- Just as in the overthrow of Sodom and Gomorrah and her neighbor towns, Yehowah has said, no man will dwell there, and no son of mankind will reside in her as an alien. (Jeremiah 49:18)
