Zephaniah 3:15" Yehowah has removed the judgments upon you. He has turned away your enemy. The king of Israel, Yehowah, is in the midst of you. You will fear calamity no more.

[14] - References:

- SPEAK to the heart of Jerusalem and call out to her that her military service has been fulfilled, that her error has been paid off. For from the hand of Yehowah she has received a full amount for all her sins. (Isaiah 40:2)
- And it must occur that just as you became a malediction among the nations, O house of Judah and house of Israel, so I shall save you, and you must become a blessing. Do not be afraid. May your hands be strong. (Zechariah 8:13)
- And my enemy will see, and shame will cover her, who was saying to me; Where is he, Yehowah your God? My own eyes will look upon her. Now she will become a place of trampling, like the mire of streets. (Micah 7:10)
- For here I am waving my hand against them, and they will have to become spoil to their slaves. And you people will certainly know that Yehowah of armies himself has sent me. (Zechariah 2:9)
- Who will file accusation against God's chosen ones? God is the One who declares them righteous. (Romans 8:33)
- For Yehowah is our Judge, Yehowah is our Statute-giver, Yehowah is our King, he himself will save us. (Isaiah 33:22)
- Round about there will be eighteen thousand cubits, and the name of the city from that day on will be Yehowah Himself Is There. (Ezekiel 48:35)
- That is why they are before the throne of God, and they are rendering him sacred service day and night in his temple, and the One seated on the throne will spread his tent over them.

 (Revelation 7:15)
- And I shall certainly plant them upon their ground, and they will no more be uprooted from their ground that I have given them, Yehowah your God has said. (Amos 9:15)

- And people will certainly inhabit her, and there will occur no more any banning to destruction, and Jerusalem must be inhabited in security. (Zechariah 14:11)
- So that anyone blessing himself in the earth will bless himself by the God of faith, and anyone making a sworn statement in the earth will swear by the God of faith, because the former distresses will actually be forgotten and because they will actually be concealed from my eyes. (Isaiah 65:16)
- For I myself well know the thoughts that I am thinking toward you, is the utterance of Yehowah, thoughts of peace, and not of calamity, to give you a future and a hope. (Jeremiah 29:11)
- By reason of your saying, These two nations and these two lands, they will become my own, and we shall certainly take possession of each land, whereas Yehowah himself happened to be right there. (Ezekiel 35:10)
- And Yehowah proceeded to answer the angel who was speaking with me, with good words, comforting words. (Zechariah 1:13)
