- **And it must occur that if you will not listen to the **voice** of **Yehowah** your **God** by taking care to do all his commandments and his statutes that I am commanding you today, all these maledictions must also come upon you and overtake you. (**Deuteronomy 28:15**)**
- **I spoke to you during your freedom from care. You said, I shall not obey. This has been your way since your youth, for you did not obey my **voice**. (**Jeremiah 22:21**)**
- **And they proceeded to come in and take possession of it, but they did not obey your **voice**, and in your Law they did not walk. All the things that you commanded them to do they did not do, so that you caused all this calamity to befall them. (**Jeremiah 32:23**)**
- **Why, you, you have hated **discipline**, and you keep throwing my words behind you. (**Psalms 50:17**)**
- **Where else will **you** be struck still more, in that **you** add more revolt? The whole head is in a sick condition, and the whole heart is feeble. (**Isaiah 1:5**)**
- **O **Yehowah**, are not those eyes of yours toward faithfulness? You have struck them, but they did not become ill. You exterminated them. They refused to take **discipline**. They made their faces harder than a crag. They refused to turn back. (**Jeremiah 5:3**)**
- **For they did not put faith in **God**, and they did not **trust** in salvation by him. (**Psalms 78:22**)**
- **Woe to those going down to Egypt for assistance, those who rely on mere horses, and who put their **trust** in war chariots, because they are numerous, and in steeds, because they are very mighty, but who have not looked to the Holy One of Israel and have not searched for **Yehowah** himself. (**Isaiah 31:1**)**

- This is what **Yehowah** has said; Cursed is the able-bodied man who puts his **trust** in earthling man and actually makes flesh his arm, and whose heart turns away from **Yehowah** himself. (**Jeremiah 17:5**)
- And they say to the true **God**, Turn away from us! And in the knowledge of your ways we have found no delight. (**Job 21:14**)
- And **Yehowah** says; For the reason that this people have come **near** with their mouth, and they have glorified me merely with their lips, and they have removed their heart itself far away from me, and their fear toward me becomes men's commandment that is being taught. (**Isaiah 29:13**)
- Let us approach with true hearts in the full assurance of faith, having had our hearts sprinkled from a wicked conscience and our bodies bathed with clean water. (**Hebrews 10:22**)
- Furthermore, I said to **you**; I am **Yehowah YOUR God**. **You** must not fear the gods of the Amorites in whose land **you** are dwelling. And **you** did not listen to my voice. (**Judges 6:10**)
- And it came about that, as if it were the most trivial thing for him to walk in the sins of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, he now took as wife Jezebel the daughter of Ethbaal the king of the Sidonians and began to go and serve Baal and to bow down to him. (**1 Kings 16:31**)
- To no effect I have struck **YOUR** sons. No **discipline** did they take. **YOUR** sword has devoured **YOUR** prophets, like a lion that is causing ruin. (**Jeremiah 2:30**)
- And you must say to them; This is the nation whose people have not obeyed the **voice** of **Yehowah** its **God**, and have not taken **discipline**. Faithfulness has perished, and it has been cut off from their mouth. (**Jeremiah 7:28**)
- To the city the very **voice** of **Yehowah** calls out, and the person of practical wisdom will fear your name. Hear the rod and who it was that designated it, O **you** people. (**Micah 6:9**)
