- What is there yet to do for my vineyard that I have not already done in it? Why is it that I hoped for it to produce grapes, but it gradually produced wild grapes? (**Isaiah 5:4**)
- And he went on to say; Surely they are my people, sons that **will** not prove false. So it was to them that he came to be a Savior. (**Isaiah 63:8**)
- Saying; If you, even you, had discerned in this day the things having to do with peace, but now they have been hid from your eyes. (**Luke 19:42**)
- Yehowah is not slow respecting his promise, as some people consider slowness, but he is patient with **you** because he does not desire any to be destroyed but desires all to attain to repentance. (**2 Peter 3:9**)
- I, in turn, shall certainly keep **you** residing in this place, in the land that I gave to **your** forefathers, from time indefinite even to time indefinite. (**Jeremiah 7:7**)
- They saying; Turn back, please, every one from his bad way and from the badness of **your dealings**, and continue **dwelling** upon the ground that Yehowah gave to **you** and to **your** forefathers from long ago and to a long time to come. (**Jeremiah 25:5**)
- But they were continually **making** jest at the messengers of the true God and despising his words and mocking at his prophets, until the rage of Yehowah came up **against** his people, until there was no healing. (**2 Chronicles 36:16**)
- So God saw the earth and, look! It was ruined, because all flesh had ruined its way on the earth. (**Genesis 6:12**)
- They have **acted** ruinously on their own part; They are not his children, the defect is their own. A generation crooked and twisted! (**Deuteronomy 32:5**)

- They have gone down deep in bringing ruin, as in the days of Gibeah. He **will** remember their error, he **will** give attention to their sins. (**Hosea 9:9**)
- Woe to those who are scheming what is harmful, and to those practicing what is bad, upon their beds! By the light of the morning they proceed to do it, because it is in the power of their hand. (**Micah 2:1**)
- We have unquestionably **acted** corruptly **against** you and have not kept the commandments and the regulations and the judicial decisions that you gave in command to Moses your servant. (**Nehemiah 1:7**)
- Listen to counsel and **accept** discipline, in order that you may become wise in your future. (**Proverbs 19:20**)
- Be corrected, O Jerusalem, that my soul may not turn away disgusted from you, that I may not set you as a desolate waste, a land not inhabited. (**Jeremiah 6:8**)
- And you **must** say to them; This is the nation whose people have not obeyed the voice of Yehowah its God, and have not taken discipline. Faithfulness has perished, and it has been **cut** off from their mouth. (**Jeremiah 7:28**)
- But they did not listen or incline their ear, and they proceeded to harden their neck in order not to hear and in order to receive no discipline. (**Jeremiah 17:23**)
- But the nations became wrathful, and your own wrath came, and the appointed time for the dead to be judged, and to give their reward to your slaves the prophets and to the holy ones and to those fearing your name, the small and the great, and to bring to ruin those ruining the earth. (**Revelation 11:18**)
