Zephaniah 3:8. Therefore keep yourselves in expectation of me, is the utterance of Yehowah, till the day of my rising up¹ to the booty,² for my judicial decision is to gather nations, for me to collect together kingdoms, in order to pour out upon them my denunciation, all my burning anger, for by the fire of my zeal all the earth³ will be devoured.

- Hope in Yehowah, be courageous and let your heart be strong. Yes, hope in Yehowah. (Psalms 27:14)
- Hope in Yehowah and keep his way, and he will exalt you to take possession of the earth. When the wicked ones are cut off, you will see it. (Psalms 37:34)
- Indeed toward God is my soul waiting in silence. From him my salvation is. (Psalms 62:1)
- Let Israel keep waiting for Yehowah. For there is loving-kindness with Yehowah, and abundantly so is there redemption with him. (Psalms 130:7)
- Do not say; I will pay back evil! Hope in Yehowah, and he will save you. (Proverbs 20:22)
- And therefore Yehowah will keep in expectation of showing you favor, and therefore he will rise up to show you mercy. For Yehowah is a God of judgment. Happy are all those keeping in expectation of him. (Isaiah 30:18)
- Exercise patience, therefore, brothers, until the presence of the Lord. Look! The farmer keeps waiting for the precious fruit of the earth, exercising patience over it until he gets the early rain and the late rain. (James 5:7)

- Like a mighty man Yehowah himself will go forth. Like a warrior he will awaken zeal. He will shout, yes, he will let out a war cry, over his enemies he will show himself mightier. (Isaiah 42:13)
- I will also collect together all the nations and bring them down to the low plain of Jehoshaphat, and I will put myself on judgment with them there on account of my people and my inheritance Israel, whom they scattered among the nations, and they apportioned out my own land. (Joel 3:2)
- And I shall certainly gather all the nations against Jerusalem for the war, and the city will actually be captured and the houses be pillaged, and the women themselves will be raped. And half of the city must go forth into the exile, but as for the remaining ones of the people, they will not be cut off from the city. (Zechariah 14:2)
- They are, in fact, expressions inspired by demons and perform signs, and they go forth to the kings of the entire inhabited earth, to gather them together to the war of the great day of God the Almighty. (Revelation 16:14)
- And I saw the wild beast and the kings of the earth and their armies gathered together to wage the war with the one seated on the horse and with his army. (Revelation 19:19)
- Pour out upon them your denunciation, and may your own burning anger overtake them. (Psalms 69:24)
- But Yehowah is in truth God. He is the living God and the King to time indefinite. Because of his indignation the earth will rock, and no nations will hold up under his denunciation. (Jeremiah 10:10)
- For a fire has been ignited in my anger and it will burn down to Sheol, the lowest place, and it will consume the earth and its produce and will set ablaze the foundations of mountains. (Deuteronomy 32:22)
- For Yehowah has indignation against all the nations, and rage against all their army. He must devote them to destruction, he must give them to the slaughter. (Isaiah 34:2)
- Therefore this is what the Sovereign Lord Yehowah has said; Certainly in the fire of my zeal I will speak against the remaining ones of the nations and against Edom, all of it, those who have

- given my land to themselves as a possession with the rejoicing of all the heart, with scorn in the soul, for the sake of its pasture ground and for the plunder. (Ezekiel 36:5)
- Neither their silver nor their gold will be able to deliver them in the day of Yehowah's fury, but by the fire of his zeal the whole earth will be devoured, because he will make an extermination, indeed a terrible one, of all the inhabitants of the earth. (Zephaniah 1:18)
- Look! The name of Yehowah is coming from far away, burning with his anger and with heavy clouds. As for his lips, they have become full of denunciation, and his tongue is like a devouring fire. (Isaiah 30:27)
- And he is also wise and will bring in what is calamitous, and he has not called back his own words, and he will certainly rise up against the house of evildoers and against the assistance of those practicing what is hurtful. (Isaiah 31:2)
- This is what Yehowah of armies has said, Look! A calamity is going forth from nation to nation, and a great tempest itself will be roused up from the remotest parts of the earth. (Jeremiah 25:32)
- But as for you, you keep seeking great things for yourself. Do not keep on seeking. For here I am bringing in a calamity upon all flesh, is the utterance of Yehowah, and I will give you your soul as a spoil in all the places to which you may go. (Jeremiah 45:5)
- And the king will actually do according to his own will, and he will exalt himself and magnify himself above every god, and against the God of gods he will speak marvelous things. And he will certainly prove successful until the denunciation will have come to a finish, because the thing decided upon must be done. (Daniel 11:36)
- Lend YOUR aid and come, all YOU nations round about, and collect yourselves together. To that place, O Yehowah, bring your powerful ones down. (Joel 3:11)
- And I shall certainly overthrow the throne of kingdoms and annihilate the strength of the kingdoms of the nations, and I will overthrow the chariot and its riders, and the horses and their

- riders will certainly come down, each one by the sword of his brother. (Haggai 2:22)
- Keep silence, all flesh, before Yehowah, for he has aroused himself from his holy dwelling. (Zechariah 2:13)
- And I heard a loud voice out of the sanctuary say to the seven angels; Go and pour out the seven bowls of the anger of God into the earth. (Revelation 16:1)
