PURIFICATION - LEPROSY - PRIEST MUST SPLATTER IT

Sanctuary ··· Purification ··· Leprosy - Priest must spatter is seven times upon the one clean from leprosy and pronounce him clean, send away the living bird over the open field · (Leviticus 14:7) [10] -References

Leviticus 14:7... Then he must spatter it seven times upon the one cleansing himself from the leprosy and he must pronounce him clean, and he must send away the living bird over the open field.

[10] - References

- For if the blood of goats and of bulls and the ashes of a heifer sprinkled on those who have been defiled sanctifies to the extent of cleanness of the flesh. (Hebrews 9:13)
- However, Elisha sent a messenger to him, saying; Going there, you must bathe seven times in the Jordan that your flesh may come back to you, and be clean. (2 Kings 5:10)
- But if in its place the blotch should stand, it has not spread, it is the inflammation of the boil, and the priest must pronounce him clean. (Leviticus 13:23)
- And the goat must carry upon itself all their errors into a desert land, and he must send the goat away into the wilderness. (Leviticus 16:22)
- As far off as the sunrise is from the sunset, so far off from us he has put our transgressions. (Psalms 103:12)
- And on the eighth day he must bring them for establishing his purification to the priest at the entrance of the tent of meeting before Yehowah. (Leviticus 14:23)
- And the priest must spatter with his right finger some of the oil that is upon his left palm seven times before Yehowah. (Leviticus 14:27)
- And he must take the cedar wood and the hyssop and the coccus scarlet material and the live bird and dip them in the blood of the bird

that was killed and in the running water, and he must spatter it toward the house seven times. (Leviticus 14:51)

- But the goat over which the lot came up for Azazel should be stood alive before Yehowah to make atonement for it, so as to send it away for Azazel into the wilderness. (Leviticus 16:10)
- And Aaron must lay both his hands upon the head of the live goat and confess over it all the errors of the sons of Israel and all their revolts in all their sins, and he must put them upon the head of the goat and send it away by the hand of a ready man into the wilderness. (Leviticus 16:21)
