PURIFICATION - RESTFUL ODOR TO GOD

Sanctuary ··· Services ··· Restful Odor To God - Its intestines and shanks washed with water, Priest to make smoke upon the altar, restful odor to Yehowah (Leviticus 1:9) [20] - References

Leviticus 1:9... And its intestines and its shanks will be washed with water, and the priest must make all of it smoke on the altar as a burnt offering, an offering made by fire of a restful odor to Yehowah.

[20] - References

- And the intestines and the shanks he washed with water, and Moses then made the entire ram smoke upon the altar. It was a burnt offering for a restful odor. It was an offering made by fire to Yehowah, just as Yehowah had commanded Moses. (Leviticus 8:21)
- Further, he washed the intestines and the shanks and made them smoke upon the burnt offering on the altar. (Leviticus 9:14)
- And Yehowah began to smell a restful odor, and so Yehowah said in his heart; Never again shall I call down evil upon the ground on man's account, because the inclination of the heart of man is bad from his youth up, and never again shall I deal every living thing a blow just as I have done. (Genesis 8:21)
- And you must make the entire ram smoke upon the altar. It is a burnt offering to Yehowah, a restful odor. It is an offering made by fire to Yehowah. (Exodus 29:18)
- And you must render up an offering made by fire to Yehowah, a burnt offering or a sacrifice to perform a special vow or voluntarily or during your seasonal festivals, in order to make a restful odor to Yehowah, from the herd or from the flock. (Numbers 15:3)
- And go on walking in love, just as the Christ also loved You and delivered himself up for You as an offering and a sacrifice to God for a sweet-smelling odor. (Ephesians 5:2)
- However, I have all things in full and have an abundance. I am filled, now that I have received from Epaphroditus the things from YOU, a sweet-smelling odor, an acceptable sacrifice, well-pleasing to God. (Philippians 4:18)

- And you must take all the fat that covers the intestines, and the appendage upon the liver, and the two kidneys and the fat that is upon them, and you must make them smoke upon the altar. (Exodus 29:13)
- And he will wash the intestines and the shanks with water, and the priest must present all of it and make it smoke on the altar. It is a burnt offering, an offering made by fire of a restful odor to Yehowah. (Leviticus 1:13)
- And Aaron's sons must make it smoke on the altar, upon the burnt offering that is over the wood that is on the fire, as an offering made by fire of a restful odor to Yehowah. (Leviticus 3:5)
- And he will remove all its fat, just as the fat was removed from off the communion sacrifice, and the priest must make it smoke on the altar as a restful odor to Yehowah, and the priest must make an atonement for him, and so it must be forgiven him. (Leviticus 4:31)
- And the priest must make them smoke on the altar as an offering made by fire to Yehowah. It is a guilt offering. (Leviticus 7:5)
- These are the seasonal festivals of Yehowah that you should proclaim as holy conventions, for presenting an offering made by fire to Yehowah, the burnt offering and the grain offering of the sacrifice and the drink offerings according to the daily schedule. (Leviticus 23:37)
- Every native should render up these in this way in presenting an offering made by fire, of a restful odor to Yehowah. (Numbers 15:13)
- And you must present as an offering made by fire, a burnt offering to Yehowah, two young bulls and one ram and seven male lambs each a year old. They should prove to be sound ones for you. (Numbers 28:19)
- And you must render up your burnt offerings, the flesh and the blood, upon the altar of Yehowah your God, and the blood of your sacrifices should be poured out against the altar of Yehowah your God, but the flesh you may eat. (Deuteronomy 12:27)
- With whole stones you should build the altar of Yehowah your God, and you must offer burnt offerings to Yehowah your God on it. (Deuteronomy 27:6)
- Let them instruct Jacob in your judicial decisions and Israel in your Law. Let them render up incense before your nostrils and a whole offering on your altar. (Deuteronomy 33:10)

- Further, he made ten basins, and put five to the right and five to the left, to wash in them. Things having to do with the burnt offering they would rinse in them. But the sea was for the priests to wash in it. (2 Chronicles 4:6)
- That they may continually be presenting soothing offerings to the God of the heavens and praying for the life of the king and his sons. (Ezra 6:10)
