

## OFFERINGS - COMMUNION - SHOULD PROVE TO BE SOUND ONE

~ **Sanctuary** ... **Offering** ... **Communion** - Should prove to be a sound one of the herd or flock, no defect in it. (**Leviticus 22:21**) <sup>[13]</sup> -

**Leviticus 22:21**... And in case a man should present a communion sacrifice to Yehowah in order to pay a vow or as a voluntary offering, it should prove to be a sound one among the herd or the flock, in order to gain approval. No defect at all should prove to be in it.

[13] - References

- And if his **offering** is a **communion sacrifice**, if he is presenting it from the **herd**, whether a male or a female, a **sound** one is what he will **present** before Yehowah. (**Leviticus 3:1**)
- But in case you should render up a male of the **herd** as a burnt **offering** or a **sacrifice** to perform a special **vow** or **communion sacrifices** to Yehowah. (**Numbers 15:8**)
- In case you **vow** a **vow** to Yehowah your God, you must not be slow about paying it, because Yehowah your God will without fail require it of you, and it would indeed become a sin on your part. (**Deuteronomy 23:21**)
- Offer thanksgiving as your **sacrifice** to God, and **pay** to the Most High your **vows**. (**Psalms 50:14**)
- So I will make melody to your name forever, that I may **pay** my **vows** day after day. (**Psalms 61:8**)
- Whenever you **vow** a **vow** to God, do not hesitate to **pay** it, for there is no delight in the stupid ones. What you **vow**, **pay**. (**Ecclesiastes 5:4**)
- Now this is the Law of the **communion sacrifice** that anyone will **present** to Yehowah. (**Leviticus 7:11**)
- And if the **sacrifice** of his **offering** is a **vow** or a **voluntary offering**, it is to be eaten on the day of his presenting his **sacrifice**, and on the next day what is left of it also may be eaten. (**Leviticus 7:16**)

- Speak to Aaron, saying; No **man** of your seed throughout their generations in whom there **proves** to be a **defect** may come near to **present** the bread of his God. (**Leviticus 21:17**)
- And **you** must render up an **offering** made by fire to **Yehowah**, a burnt **offering** or a **sacrifice** to perform a special **vow** or voluntarily or during **your** seasonal festivals, in **order** to make a restful odor to **Yehowah**, from the **herd** or from the **flock**. (**Numbers 15:3**)
- These **you** will render up to **Yehowah** at **your** seasonal festivals, besides **your vow offerings** and **your voluntary offerings** as **your** burnt **offerings** and **your** grain **offerings** and **your** drink **offerings** and **your communion sacrifices**. (**Numbers 29:39**)
- For your servant made a solemn **vow** when I was dwelling in Geshur in Syria, saying; If **Yehowah** will without fail bring me back to Jerusalem, I must also render service to Yehowah. (**2 Samuel 15:8**)
- And King Ahaz went on to command him, even Urijah the priest, saying; Upon the great altar make the burnt **offering** of the morning smoke, also the grain **offering** of the evening and the burnt **offering** of the king and his grain **offering** and the burnt **offering** of all the people of the land and their grain **offering** and their drink **offerings**, and all the blood of burnt **offering** and all the blood of a **sacrifice** you should sprinkle upon it. As for the copper altar, it will become something for me to take under consideration. (**2 Kings 16:15**)
