OFFERINGS - COMMUNION - SHOULD PROVE TO BE SOUND ONE

~ Sanctuary ··· Offering ··· Communion - Should prove to be a sound one of the herd or flock, no defect in it· (Leviticus 22:21) [13] - References

Leviticus 22:21... And in case a man should present a communion sacrifice to Yehowah in order to pay a vow or as a voluntary offering, it should prove to be a sound one among the herd or the flock, in order to gain approval. No defect at all should prove to be in it.

[13] - References

- And if his offering is a communion sacrifice, if he is presenting it from the herd, whether a male or a female, a sound one is what he will present before Yehowah. (Leviticus 3:1)
- But in case you should render up a male of the herd as a burnt offering or a sacrifice to perform a special vow or communion sacrifices to Yehowah. (Numbers 15:8)
- In case you vow a vow to Yehowah your God, you must not be slow about paying it, because Yehowah your God will without fail require it of you, and it would indeed become a sin on your part. (Deuteronomy 23:21)
- Offer thanksgiving as your sacrifice to God, and pay to the Most High your vows. (Psalms 50:14)
- So I will make melody to your name forever, that I may pay my vows day after day. (Psalms 61:8)
- Whenever you vow a vow to God, do not hesitate to pay it, for there is no delight in the stupid ones. What you vow, pay. (Ecclesiastes 5:4)
- Now this is the Law of the communion sacrifice that anyone will present to Yehowah. (Leviticus 7:11)
- And if the sacrifice of his offering is a vow or a voluntary offering, it is to be eaten on the day of his presenting his sacrifice, and on the next day what is left of it also may be eaten. (Leviticus 7:16)

- Speak to Aaron, saying; No man of your seed throughout their generations in whom there proves to be a defect may come near to present the bread of his God. (Leviticus 21:17)
- And you must render up an offering made by fire to Yehowah, a burnt offering or a sacrifice to perform a special vow or voluntarily or during your seasonal festivals, in order to make a restful odor to Yehowah, from the herd or from the flock. (Numbers 15:3)
- These you will render up to Yehowah at your seasonal festivals, besides your vow offerings and your voluntary offerings as your burnt offerings and your grain offerings and your drink offerings and your communion sacrifices. (Numbers 29:39)
- For your servant made a solemn vow when I was dwelling in Geshur in Syria, saying; If Yehowah will without fail bring me back to Jerusalem, I must also render service to Yehowah. (2 Samuel 15:8)
- And King Ahaz went on to command him, even Urijah the priest, saying; Upon the great altar make the burnt offering of the morning smoke, also the grain offering of the evening and the burnt offering of the king and his grain offering and the burnt offering of all the people of the land and their grain offering and their drink offerings, and all the blood of burnt offering and all the blood of a sacrifice you should sprinkle upon it. As for the copper altar, it will become something for me to take under consideration. (2 Kings 16:15)
