

OFFERINGS - COMMUNION - THANKSGIVING

~ **Sanctuary ... Offering ... Communion Thanksgiving -**
unfermented ring-shaped cakes moistened with oil and well mixed fine
flour, unleavened wafers' (Leviticus 7:12) ^[18] - References

Leviticus 7:12'' If he would present it in expression of thanksgiving, then he must present along with the sacrifice of thanksgiving unleavened ring-shaped cakes moistened with oil and unleavened wafers smeared with oil and well-mixed fine flour as ring-shaped cakes moistened with oil.

- And in case **you** should **sacrifice** a **thanksgiving sacrifice** to Yehowah, **you** should **sacrifice** it to gain approval for **you**. (Leviticus 22:29)
- Finally Hezekiah answered and said; Now **you** have filled **your** hand with power for Yehowah. Approach, and bring **sacrifices** and **thanksgiving sacrifices** to the house of Yehowah. And the congregation began to bring **sacrifices** and **thanksgiving sacrifices**, and also every one willing of heart, burnt offerings. (2 Chronicles 29:31)
- And they proceeded to **sacrifice** on that day great **sacrifices** and to rejoice, for the true God himself caused them to rejoice with great joy. And also the women and the children themselves rejoiced, so that the rejoicing of Jerusalem could be heard far away. (Nehemiah 12:43)
- Offer **thanksgiving** as your **sacrifice** to God, and pay to the Most High your vows. (Psalms 50:14)
- In everything **you** are being enriched for every sort of generosity, which produces through us an **expression** of thanks to God. (2 Corinthians 9:11)
- And in case you would **present** as an offering a grain offering in the way of something baked in the oven, it should be of **fine flour**, **unleavened ring-shaped cakes moistened** with **oil** or **unleavened wafers smeared** with **oil**. (Leviticus 2:4)

- And what is left of it Aaron and his sons will eat. It will be eaten as **unfermented cakes** in a holy place. They will eat it in the courtyard of the tent of meeting. (**Leviticus 6:16**)
- And a basket of **unfermented ring-shaped cakes** of **fine flour**, **moistened** with **oil**, and **unfermented wafers smeared** with **oil**, and their grain offering and their drink offerings. (**Numbers 6:15**)
- And **unfermented** bread and **unfermented ring-shaped cakes** **moistened** with **oil** and **unfermented wafers smeared** with **oil**. Out of **fine** wheat **flour** you will make them. (**Exodus 29:2**)
- And out of the basket of **unfermented cakes** that was before Yehowah he took one **unfermented ring-shaped** cake and one **ring-shaped** cake of oiled bread and one wafer. He then placed them upon the fatty pieces and the right leg. (**Leviticus 8:26**)
- Even for the layer bread and for the **fine flour** for the grain offering and for the **wafers** of **unfermented** bread and for the griddle **cakes** and for the mixed dough and for all measures of quantity and size. (**1 Chronicles 23:29**)
- Moreover, he prepared the altar of Yehowah and began to **sacrifice** upon it communion **sacrifices** and **thanksgiving sacrifices** and went on to say to Judah to serve Yehowah the God of Israel. (**2 Chronicles 33:16**)
- And let them offer the **sacrifices** of **thanksgiving** and declare his works with a joyful cry. (**Psalms 107:22**)
- To you I shall offer the **sacrifice** of **thanksgiving**, and on the name of Yehowah I shall call. (**Psalms 116:17**)
- The sound of exultation and the sound of rejoicing, the voice of the bridegroom and the voice of the bride, the voice of those saying; **LAUD** Yehowah of armies, for Yehowah is good, for to time indefinite is his loving-kindness! They will be bringing a **thanksgiving** offering into the house of Yehowah, for I shall bring back the captives of the land just as at the start, Yehowah has said. (**Jeremiah 33:11**)
- And from what is leavened make a **thanksgiving sacrifice** to smoke, and proclaim voluntary offerings, publish it, for that is the way **you** have loved, O sons of Israel, is the utterance of the Sovereign Lord Yehowah. (**Amos 4:5**)

- But if **YOU** people offer up to me whole burnt offerings, even in **YOUR** gift offerings I shall find no pleasure, and on **YOUR** communion **sacrifices** of fatlings I shall not look. (**Amos 5:22**)
- Through him let us always offer to God a **sacrifice** of praise, that is, the fruit of lips which make public declaration to his name. (**Hebrews 13:15**)
