OFFERINGS - COMMUNION - VOW MUST BE EATEN SAME DAY

Sanctuary ··· Offering ··· Communion - Vow Must be eaten same day or next day· (Leviticus 7:16) [15] - References

Leviticus 7:16... And if the sacrifice of his offering is a vow or a voluntary offering, it is to be eaten on the day of his presenting his sacrifice, and on the next day what is left of it also may be eaten.

[15] - References

- And in case a man should present a communion sacrifice to Yehowah in order to pay a vow or as a voluntary offering, it should prove to be a sound one among the herd or the flock, in order to gain approval. No defect at all should prove to be in it. (Leviticus 22:21)
- And these were the names of Aaron's sons, the firstborn Nadab and Abihu, Eleazar and Ithamar. (Numbers 3:2)
- Then Jephthah made a vow to Yehowah and said; If you without fail give the sons of Ammon into my hand. (Judges 11:30)
- And she went on to make a vow and say; O Yehowah of armies, if you will without fail look upon the affliction of your slave girl and actually remember me, and you will not forget your slave girl and actually give to your slave girl a male offspring, I will give him to Yehowah all the days of his life, and no razor will come upon his head. (1 Samuel 1:11)
- I shall come into your house with whole burnt offerings, I shall pay to you my vows (Psalms 66:13)
- It is a snare when earthling man has rashly cried out, Holy! And after vows he is disposed to make examination. (Proverbs 20:25)
- Whenever you vow a vow to God, do not hesitate to pay it, for there is no delight in the stupid ones. What you vow, pay. (Ecclesiastes 5:4)
- Therefore do this which we tell you; We have four men with a vow upon themselves. (Acts of Apostles 21:23)

- As for a bull or a sheep having a member too long or too short, you may make it a voluntary offering, but for a vow it will not be accepted with approval. (Leviticus 22:23)
- And there you must bring your burnt offerings and your sacrifices and your tenth parts and the contribution of your hand and your vow offerings and your voluntary offerings and the firstborn ones of your herd and of your flock. (Deuteronomy 12:6)
- Speak to Aaron and his sons and all the sons of Israel, and you must say to them, As for any man of the house of Israel or some alien resident in Israel who presents his offering, for any of their vows or for any of their voluntary offerings, which they may present to Yehowah for a burnt offering. (Leviticus 22:18)
- And you must render up an offering made by fire to Yehowah, a burnt offering or a sacrifice to perform a special vow or voluntarily or during your seasonal festivals, in order to make a restful odor to Yehowah, from the herd or from the flock. (Numbers 15:3)
- But in case you should render up a male of the herd as a burnt offering or a sacrifice to perform a special vow or communion sacrifices to Yehowah. (Numbers 15:8)
- These you will render up to Yehowah at your seasonal festivals, besides your vow offerings and your voluntary offerings as your burnt offerings and your grain offerings and your drink offerings and your communion sacrifices. (Numbers 29:39)
- And it must occur that the place that Yehowah YOUR God will choose to have his name reside there is where YOU will bring all about which I am commanding YOU, YOUR burnt offerings and YOUR sacrifices, YOUR tenth parts and the contribution of YOUR hand and every choice of YOUR vow offerings that YOU will vow to Yehowah. (Deuteronomy 12:11)
